Across the Atlantic: End of winning streak

The Dow Jones industrial average tumbled by as much as 145 points before finishing 53 points, or about 0.4 percent lower.

The market came under early pressure after reports that investments in two leveraged funds run by Bear Stearns are now nearly worthless, with Federal Reserve Chairman **Ben Bernanke** telling Congress the situation would likely get worse before getting better. Speaking to a Congressional committee, the Fed chief said that he sees moderate economic growth to pick up gradually this year, but said that the central bank is still wary about inflation.

Pfizer fell \$0.83 to \$25.13 posted a decline in quarterly profit, hurt by generic competition, sending its shares over 3 percent. **Altria** was down \$0.98 to \$70.30 as it reported lower profits that topped expectations, but cut its full-year earnings forecast, while **United Technologies** booked higher profits. **22** of the **30** Dow components finished lower. IBM reported better-than-expected profits and sales when it reported quarterly earnings.

EBay also reported earnings and revenue that beat analyst projections, helped by strength in its auction business. Stocks retreated earlier in the session following disappointing earnings news from **Yahoo** down \$1.33 to \$26.20 and **Intel** down \$1.27 to \$25.06. Shares of the two companies fell nearly 5 percent on the Nasdag.

Treasury prices climbed, lowering the yield on the benchmark 10-year note to 5.02 percent from 5.07 percent late Tuesday. U.S. light **crude** for August delivery jumped \$1.02 to \$75.02 a barrel on the New York Mercantile Exchange.

The dollar fell against the euro and the yen. COMEX gold for August gained \$7.80 to \$673.70

Trading **volumes** showed 1.7 billion shares exchanging hands on the New York Stock Exchange and 2.2 billion on the Nasdaq. **Declining issues** topped gainers by **20 to 11** on the NYSE and by 9 to 5 on the Nasdaq.
