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Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks rallied on Tuesday, lifting the Dow Jones Industrial Average by over 150 points, as investors extended a recovery in Asian markets and the dollar overnight, spurring hopes that markets can regain a portion of the massive losses suffered over the past week. A rebound in overseas markets reassured investors following last week's global decline, pushing the Dow industrials to their biggest gain in more than eight months.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average WAS AT 12,207.59 gained 157 points to 12,207, posting its biggest one-day gain since July 2006.

Of the Dow's 30 components, 29 were in the green. The broader S&P 500 index gained almost 1.6 percent, while the tech-heavy Nasdaq up 44.46 added 1.9 percent. The Russell 2000 was up 18.82 to 778.8.

Market breadth was positive. On the New York Stock Exchange, winners trounced losers by almost 5 to 1 on volume of 1.83 billion shares. On the Nasdaq, advancers beat decliners by 4 to 1 on volume of 2.16 billion shares.

Financial shares, at least on the Dow, also received some relief after being battered over the past week amid concerns about rising loan defaults and distressed mortgage lenders. A variety of subprime mortgage lenders bounced back, after stumbling on Monday. New Century Financial, NovaStar Financial, Accredited Home Lenders and Fremont General all posted big gains. Commodity stocks all bounced back, too. In currency trading, the dollar rallied against the yen and edged higher versus the euro.

Citigroup launched a \$10.7 billion takeover bid for Nikko Cordial, a scandal-plagued Japanese brokerage that Citigroup already has a 5 percent stake in. Citigroup shares rose 2.7 percent, and other financial shares bounced back as well, including Bear Stearns up \$4.50 to \$149.00, Lehman Bros up \$3.11 to \$74.23 and Goldman Sachs up \$7.37 to \$197.37.

Google rose 3.8 percent after it tied up with Apple.
