VIEW POINT: COOLING DOWN

The markets are likely to pause and take stock of two days of relentless rise that cam on high volumes and a better breadth. Now that the Indices, specially the Nifty, have reached in the vicinity of their all time highs, some consolidation, would not be out of place. Bajaj Auto had spooked the market in the last 20 minutes of trade and the stock may draw some more market blood, before concerns on the Call Option given to its Insurance partner abate.

The Nifty closed just 26 points away from its all time high mark of 4245. However, the Sensex, which takes into account the free-float equity, is at some distance. While the all time high mark of 14723 is a far cry, it did not even touch the intermediate top of 14383 made in the Sensex. Weakness in the derivatives may be lead by Bajaj Auto and the 31 new recruits, which showed the first signs of crack yesterday. Another concern that has suddenly cropped up is Crude, which is just camped under \$ 65. Time to protect profits and capital.

The markets had always given a premium to Bajaj Auto, as compared to Hero Honda. And the reason for giving this higher valuation was the pot of gold, in the form of the insurance business. It now transpires that Alliance holds a call option to raise their equity to 50% at a price that will give them a 16% return per annum on the face value of Rs 10, in case the option is exercise before 2016. With the upside , now capped, Bajaj Auto 's valuations may revert to those prevailing for two-wheelers.

Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks ended lower Thursday, as investors consolidated some of the previous session's strong gains, and with a surge in crude oil prices offsetting upbeat outlooks from Hewlett-Packard and JC Penney.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** briefly crossed 13,500 for the first time ever, but it retreated and finished down 10.81 points, or 0.08%, to 13,476.72. The **S&P 500** slipped 1.39 points, or 0.09%, to 1512.75, and the **Nasdaq** gave back 8.04 points, or 0.32%, to 2539.38.

Several firms made changes on stock ratings. On the upside, AG Edwards raised its rating for **Target** to buy from hold. The firm also assigned a stock price target of \$71 a share. Target rose 38 cents, or 0.7%, to \$57.69.

Among downgrades, Stifel Nicolaus cut its rating for Dow component **Caterpillar** to hold from buy. Caterpillar shed \$1.11, or 1.5%, to \$74.84.

Away from stocks, **Federal Reserve** Chairman Ben Bernanke spoke in Chicago on the topic of subprime mortgage markets and regulations.

Bernanke said that the Fed believes "the effect of the troubles in the subprime sector on the broader housing market will likely be limited, and we do not expect significant spillovers from the subprime market to the rest of the economy or to the financial system."

The Labor Department said **initial jobless claims** fell by 5,000 last week to 293,000. The less volatile four-week moving average dropped by 12,000 to 305,500.

Elsewhere, the **Conference Board** said that the **leading economic indicators** unexpectedly fell 0.5% during April, compared with a revised 0.6% rise in March.

Soaring demand for gasoline sent energy futures higher Thursday on the New York Mercantile Exchange, including a gain of more than 3% for oil.

The **June light sweet crude** contract advanced \$2.31 to **\$64.86** a barrel. Reformulated gasoline climbed 10 cents to \$2.44 a gallon, and heating oil was up 7 cents at \$1.94 a gallon.

The near-term natural gas contract was 19 cents better at \$8.08 per million British thermal units.

AAA, the motor club, forecast that car travel over **Memorial Day** weekend -- the start of the summer **driving season** in the U.S. -- will increase 1.8% from last year despite the fact that gasoline is selling at record-high prices.

The announcement helped lift gasoline futures 4%. Still, there remains no sign that escalating gasoline prices are making a dent in demand for motor fuel.
