VIEW POINT: ANOTHER MORNING BLOW

Our markets are likely to take a sharp rap on the knuckles this morning as the relative confidence with which the markets closed Thursday is going to do a vanishing act today. Helping exacerbate the fall is a 198-point overnight fall in the Dow, which was reacting to the sharp increase in the treasury yields. A rise in the yield indicates that the markets have given up their utopian dreams of a rate cut and are now beginning to adjust for a rate hike.

Expect the Sensex to plunge 150 odd points in the opening trade, positively breaking the 14046 support and even challenging the 14000 mark. Tatkal traders will bear the brunt of the morning fall, as they had increased their exposure following bouncing back of stocks Thursday evening. If the strength of the Dollar is reflected in our Rupee-Dollar quotes, technology stocks may take slightly less beating but there are no holy cows today.

THE INDICATOR**Across the Atlantic**

U.S. stocks fell sharply on Thursday, sending the Dow Jones Industrial Average down by nearly 200 points, as the yield of a key benchmark bond surged above 5%, further challenging the attractiveness of stocks

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** was down 198.94 points, or 1.5%, at 13,266.73. The **S&P 500** was off 26.66 points, or 1.8%, at 1490.72, and the **Nasdaq Composite** was lower by 45.80 points, or 1.8%, at 2541.38.

Each one of the 30 Dow components closed lower. The worst performers included **Wal-Mart, Microsoft, 3M** and **AT&T**.

Investors have been warily monitoring rising **bond yields** since last week. Higher yields make bonds more attractive to investors relative to riskier bets in the stock market. Better-than-expected economic data, along with hawkish comments by Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke and other Fed officials have pressured the price of inflation-sensitive bonds, lifting their yields.

Around 4 p.m. EDT, the **10-year Treasury note** was sinking 1 5/32 in price, yielding 5.12%, the first time it has been above 5% since last August.

The **30-year bond** was diving 2 1/32, sending the yield all the way up to 5.22%.

At the same time, rising interest rates globally are also putting pressure on stocks. On Thursday, the **New Zealand central bank** hiked rates to 8%. **The Bank of England**, on the other hand, held rates unchanged. On Wednesday, the **European Central Bank** hiked rates and issued a hawkish outlook.

In addition to rates worries, the sell-off also was fueled by the **hedging strategies** of many mortgage-backed securities portfolio managers that force them to unload Treasuries as poor-quality loans go sour. There also is a trend of foreign central banks to diversify away from long-term Treasury notes. The trends involving rates, portfolio hedging and foreign central banks diversification strategies should remain in force in coming weeks, analysts said. That would keep upward pressure on yields.

Selling accelerated after **Pimco** bond guru Bill Gross made bearish comments. As the day neared its finish, he said the yield on the 10-year Treasury could go as high as **6.5%** sometime in the next five years. Before that, the top end of his range was 5.5%.

The **dollar** was firmer against most major currencies, including the euro and the pound

Economists note that **historically** it is fairly rare for the benchmark yield to remain below the fed funds rate for as long as it has in the current rates cycle.

The Federal Reserve has kept the fed funds rate at 5.25% for the past year, after lifting it by a quarter-point 17 times in a row between June 2004 and June 2006. During the past year the benchmark yield has remained persistently below the fed funds rate, held down by widespread expectations that both the economy and inflation would cool sufficiently to induce the Fed to drop rates. However, a number of global and domestic data reports, rate hikes and other developments have pointed to unexpected resilience in the U.S. economy and strong growth abroad.

Turning to commodities, **crude futures** rose 97 cents to \$66.93 a barrel, and **gold** was softer by \$9.40 to \$665.20 an ounce.
