VIEW POINT: TERRITORIAL GAINS

Technically the markets are poised well after a record breaking close seen on Friday. Both the Nifty and the Sensex are into uncharted waters. This kind of situation is usually conducive for market's further gains. However, a tame close of the US markets and a weak opening of Japanese markets after Nissan Motors posted poor results, indicate that we may have a subdued start for the week.

On the derivative front, the Nifty dipped back into a discount of 9 points from a premium of one point Thursday. That does not seem to bother me as we have seen some stive put writing happening at the 4200 strike, taking the PCR upto a healthy 1.80. With open interest at 53809, the concerns are still some distance away.

THE INDICATOR**At the street****Anil Ambani sets eyes on Globeleq's assets**

Reliance Energy, the flagship power company of the Anil Dhirubhai Ambani Group (ADAG) is set to put in its bid for the global power assets of Globeleq, an operating power company with assets in Asia, Africa and the Americas.

The company's operations span over 13 countries and accounts for about 5,000 MW in 13 power companies. Globeleq's stake totals to about 3,000 MW, most of which are gas-based power plants.

Valued at close to \$2 billion, Globeleq is now seeking to exit from these operations by selling out its stake. It has appointed Lehman Brothers to carry out the transactions. Reliance Energy, which is planning to develop several power projects in India including the gas based power project in Dadri, has set its eyes on these assets and is expected to put in an indicative bid by mid-February.

THE INDICATOR**Across the Atlantic**

US markets finished mixed Friday with technology making it to the green, while the finished in the red. The markets were not too sure, how to read the January jobs report.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** fell 20.19 points at 12,653.49. The **S&P 500** was up 2.45 points at 1448.39, and the **Nasdaq Composite** added 7.50 points to 2475.88.

The Dow was higher for the week by 166 points, or 1.3%. The Nasdaq rose 41 points, or 1.7%, and the S&P 500 added 26 points, or 1.8%.

The monthly jobs data, among the most important pieces of economic information the government releases every month, showed that 111,000 workers were added to U.S. payrolls in January. Economists had expected 150,000 positions created, according to a *g* poll.

The jobless rate rose to 4.6% from 4.5%. No change had been anticipated. Average hourly earnings, a key inflation metric, rose a less-than-expected 0.2%.

Meanwhile, in what is becoming fairly routine, job growth for the prior two months was revised upward. The Labor Department now says 81,000 more employees were put to work in November and December than had been first thought.

The University of Michigan's consumer sentiment index slipped to a revised January reading of 96.9 from a preliminary 98.0. Economists expected a slight decrease to 97.8.

The Commerce Department said that factory orders rose a greater-than-expected 2.4% during December.
