VIEW POINT: K G BASIN ORDER A DAMPNER

The court order restraining Reliance to sell gas to anybody else than RNRL and NTPC for the first eight years could mean a serious setback to Reliance as the realization could suffer as the two users could gang up to arm-twist Reliance into pricing its gas lower. Companies associated with transport of this gas from KG basin to West Coast, might also be adversely impacted.

The US markets closed better but the Japanese markets are weak. With Reliance expected to open lower, it could take the market sentiment with it. The rise in NTPC and Reliance Energy may not be enough to compensate for the loss. Resistance for the Sensex is at 14590 and the support at 14347.

COURT SPANNER IN K G WORKS

The Centre is considering challenging the Bombay High Court's decision to restrain Reliance Industries from selling gas from its Krishna-Godavari (KG) basin block to any company other than NTPC and Anil Ambani's Reliance Natural Resources Ltd (RNRL) for the first eight years of production.

The Bombay High Court has asked RIL not to create third-party rights for the natural gas to be produced from its KG basin block in Andhra Pradesh for the first eight years starting 2008. RIL plans to begin production from the block in July 2008, with initial output of close to 40 million standard cubic metre (mscmd) of gas per day. Peak output would touch 80 mscmd later.

Unless Supreme Court stays or changes the order, the chief beneficiary of the aforesaid development would be **RNRL**, **Reliance Energy** and **NTPC**. Apart from being assured of a regular supply they could also play a role in bringing the cost of the gas down from the \$ 4.5 per unit that has been proposed by Reliance to the Government.

And **Petronet LNG's period** of good luck could get extended if the gas from KG does not reach the west coast.

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Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks finished higher after a volatile session Thursday, as a drop in crude oil prices helped to offset concerns about rising bond yields and allowed the market to rebound from the previous session's stumble

After falling by as much as 90 points earlier, the **Dow Jones Industrial Average** turned around and rose 56.42 points, or 0.42%, to 13,545.84. The **S&P 500** was up 9.35 points, or 0.62%, at 1522.19. The **Nasdaq** advanced 17 points, or 0.65%, to 2616.96.

Government bonds were softer. The 10-year note was down 8/32 in price, yielding 5.16%, while the 30-year bond was losing 18/32, yielding 5.28%.

Energy stocks, which suffered during the prior session, rebounded strongly. **Chevron**, **Hess**, **Marathon Oil** and **Occidental Petroleum** all finished higher by 2.2% or more.

Luxottica Group is planning to acquire **Oakley** in an arrangement worth \$29.30 a share, or a little over \$2 billion in total. Luxottica jumped 9.1% to \$38.02, and Oakley surged 12.8% to \$28.45.

General Electric, which said shortly after the midday mark that it would not pursue an acquisition of Dow Jones, finished higher by a penny at \$38.80.

Among the day's research calls, Piper Jaffray downgraded **Home Depot** to market perform from outperform, and Citigroup cut it's rating on **Prudential** to hold from buy. Home Depot closed down 0.2% to \$39.95, and Prudential lost 0.8% to \$99.51.

On the economic front, the **Labor Department** said **initial jobless claims** unexpectedly rose by 10,000 last week to 324,000. Economists had expected claims to come in at 311,000. Elsewhere, the Conference Board said leading economic indicators rose 0.3% in May, slightly above the consensus. The gain helped reverse a 0.5% decline in April.

The Philadelphia **Federal Reserve** said its manufacturing index for June jumped to a reading of 18.0, more than double expectations.

As for commodities, the front-month August **crude contract** lost 21 cents to **\$68.65** a barrel. Gasoline was up by a penny at \$2.24 a gallon.

Precious metals were weaker. **Silver** futures fell 16 cents to **\$13.09** an ounce. **Gold** futures lost \$8.60 to **\$651.40** an ounce
