

In September 2008, India's cement consumption grew 9.6% yoy, a sharp contrast to the weak performance in the previous month. However, the strong consumption growth is unlikely to sustain in coming months as the real estate market (largest consumer) in North and Central region continues to weaken. South market witnessed strong demand supporting firm pricing (up 4.7% yoy) in the region. However, prices might correct in the upcoming monsoon season. International coal prices and freight cost have come off significantly from their peaks but the sharp rupee deprecation of 6.3% during the month neutralizes the beneficial impact to an extent. The key concern remains the weakening cement demand due to a dip in construction and infrastructure activities in the country. We believe that cyclical downturn will start impacting realization sooner than later, leading to further contraction in margins of cement manufacturers. This could lead to de-growth in earnings for many industry players.

Rebound in consumption growth; Central and South region outperform

Indian cement consumption grew by 9.6% yoy in September 2008. Continued strong growth in South (16.3% yoy) and West (9.8% yoy) along with pick up in cement demand in the Central region (14.3% yoy) compensated for the slow growth in the North (3.7% yoy) and West (2.1% yoy) region. We believe the demand growth could slowdown to 7-7.5% this fiscal against expectations of 10-11% growth during the beginning of the year.

Contradictory pricing trend emerge; realizations remained robust in South

All-India cement prices were flat mom and higher by 1.5% yoy in September 2008. Prices continued to be buoyant in the tight-supply market of South (up 3.2% mom and 4.7% yoy). Prices remained weak in Central region (down 0.9% mom and 2.5% yoy) despite a substantial demand pick-up. Realizations were flat mom in West, North and East region. We expect all-India cement prices to remain flat over the next two-three months and then dip subsequently on account of ~30mtpa capacity coming on stream and further softening in demand.

Capacity utilization improves mom but remains lower yoy

All-India capacity utilization stood at 81.4% in the month of September as against 88.5% in September 2007. August saw a sharp decline at 77.3%. No new capacity addition took place in September. The all-India capacity stands at 204.3mpta. We expect capacity utilization at 78-80% in the current fiscal.

Key performers were players who have recently added capacities

North and Central-based companies registered a robust dispatch growth on account of a spike in construction activity ahead of the festive season. Companies like Shree Cement, Jaypee Cement and Birla Corp (North and Central based companies) registered healthy double-digit dispatch growth during the month. South-based companies that have recently expanded capacity such as Kesoram Industries (14.2% yoy), Madras Cement (22.8% yoy) and Orient Paper (14.0% yoy) continued their robust performance.

Coal prices cool from peak; freight index falls to the lowest levels since 2002.

During September 2008, international coal prices fell to US\$148/ton from US\$190/ton in August. On end-of-month basis, prices were down 23.4% mom and up 45.3% yoy, while on average rate basis; prices were lower 8.9% mom and higher 75.8% yoy. The Baltic Freight Index, a measure of commodity shipping costs declined by 53% over the month to 3,504 level. This has further corrected in the month of October to 885 levels, which is the lowest since 2002.

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



Regional price trend










