**VIEW POINT: BULL CHARGE ON DALAL STREET**

Expect markets to open with a sharp gap up on back of very bullish international cues. Once the initial hurray subsides, we expect bears to start a run for cover and that is enough to keep indices buoyant for the rest of the trade. Punters have added Rs. 2000 odd crore positions in yesterday's trade taking overall open interest beyond Rs. 65500 crore.

Dow Jones Industrial Average gained over 180 points - its best one-day gain of 2007, after an economic survey suggested moderate growth with little inflation prompting bond yields to back off 5-year highs and with it interest rate hike worries. Back home, Our indices did not trade beyond low levels seen on Tuesday and the 4100 in nifty and 13950 in sensex will act as a strong support going forward. Next meaningful resistance comes in at 4200 or 14270 levels.

**THE INDICATOR****Across the Atlantic**

U.S. stocks rallied Wednesday, with the Dow Jones Industrial Average gaining over 180 points for its best one-day gain of 2007, after an economic survey suggesting moderate growth and little inflation helped bond yields back off 5-year highs.

The Dow Jones industrial average jumped about 187 points, or 1.4 percent to 13,482.35. The S&P 500 index gained 1.5 percent to 1,515.67 while Nasdaq composite climbed 1.3 percent or 32.54 to 2,582.31. Treasury prices rose Wednesday, lowering the yield on the 10-year note to 5.20 percent from 5.29 percent late Tuesday.

Stock gains were broad based, with 28 out of 30 Dow issues rising, led by Alcoa up \$1.14 to \$40.48, Boeing up \$1.99 to \$98.47, Citigroup up \$1.08 to \$53.68, Microsoft up \$0.54 to \$30.39, 3M up \$2.15 to \$87.19 and General Motors up \$0.67 to \$32.10.

Among other stock movers, Ford Motor up \$0.24 to \$8.56 continued to gain on Tuesday's news that its looking for a buyer for its money-losing Land Rover and Jaguar brands. Blockbuster up \$0.32 to \$4.27 jumped 8 percent after Citigroup upgraded it to "buy" from "hold." The video chain also announced a new online rental plan that is cheaper than the one offered by rival Netflix. Netflix down \$0.66 to \$19.42 shares slipped on the news. Lawson Software up \$0.67 to \$10.00 jumped 7.2 percent in unusually active trade after the company said fourth-quarter earnings would top estimates.

Market breadth was positive. On the New York Stock Exchange, winners beat losers by more than 4 to 1 on volume of 1.59 billion shares. On the Nasdaq, advancers beat decliners 7 to 3 on volume of 2.15 billion shares.

U.S. light crude oil for July delivery rose \$0.91 to \$66.26 a barrel on the New York Mercantile Exchange, gaining after the weekly supply report showed a drop in refinery activity. COMEX gold for August delivery fell \$0.40 to settle at \$652.70 an ounce. In currency trading, the dollar gained modestly versus the euro and rallied against the yen, following the retail sales report.
