Markets opened on a firm note following the strong cues from the Asian markets. Both the barometer indices, Sensex & Nifty struck their highest level in more than 15 months in the early trade. Sustained buying interest in index pivotals kept key benchmark indices firm in mid-morning trade. Metal and infrastructure shares gained while Auto and Oil marketing stocks remained under selling pressure. The market breadth remained strong as business confidence sentiment improved further. Markets continued to witness continuous buying interest even in the early afternoon session. The European markets too extended positive signals. However in the last hour of trade markets suddenly turned choppy on selling pressure for profit booking. Traders resorted to unwind positions as markets had reached crucial resistance levels. Ultimately the freefall got arrested and markets got consolidated above the unchanged mark. Market volume remained low in today's session. Among the Nifty stocks HINDALCO, STER, SBIN, RELINFRA soared high while TATAPOWER, AXISBANK, HINDUNILVR, RCOM lagged behind.

Crude Oil traded at US\$ 69.43 per barrel and Rupee traded at Rs.48.65 against each US\$.

Corporate News

- McNally Bharat Engineering Company (NSE: MBECL) has recommended dividend at the rate of Rs 1.25 per share (12.5%) for the year ended 31 March 2009.
- Four Soft (NSE: FOURSOFT) has announced that its subsidiary Four Soft Netherlands BV has signed a contract with Panafresh Logistics BV, Netherlands.

Global News

British retail sales drop in August

British retail sales in August declined 0.1% (yoy) but June and July sales rose on 1.4%, 1.8% respectively (yoy). Average, comparable store sales for all categories rose 1.1% in the June-to-August period compared to the same time 2008. Food sales up 3.8%, while non-food sales down 0.7%.

❖ Japan's Current Account Surplus down in July

Japan's current account surplus slipped in July from the previous year due to a fall in the income surplus and the widening of the services deficit. The Ministry of Finance said the current account surplus dropped 19.4% (yoy) to 1.26 trillion yen from 1.57 trillion yen of 2008. The surplus was also lower than 1.45 trillion yen surplus estimated, but it increased from June's surplus of 1.15 trillion yen.

German industrial output down in July

Germany's industrial production slipped 0.9% in July from the previous month. The data was much worse than analysts expected as market participants expected a hike of about 1.6%. Output rose by a revised 0.8% in June from May.

Market Talk

Tata Steel sales grow 25% yoy

Tata steel production increased in terms of hot metal, crude steel, sale able steel over the corresponding month of 2008. August domestic steel sales jumped 25% from a year earlier to 492000 tons. The strong output came due to an 81% increase in sales of long products, used in construction, from a year earlier

Saleable steel production in August up by 14% (yoy) to 526,000 tons. Best ever hot metal production rose 15% to 5, 97, 319 tons. Crude steel production surged upto 16% to 5,52,000 tons as against 474000 tons (yoy).

August car sales up 26% (yoy)

Domestic sales of cars in India were up 26% in August helped by the government's stimulus measures and lower interest rates as per data released by the Society of Indian Automobile Manufacturers (SIAM). New launches cars have also played a role to advance the sales of automobiles.

Auto companies sold 120,669 cars during August 2009 compared with the 96,082 cars sold in the same month for the year 2008 published by SIAM. Sales of trucks and buses also advanced by 18.5% from a year earlier to 40,624 units. Motorcycle sales jumped 26% to 611,173 units from a year ago level, according to SIAM data.

- * Markets surged higher in the early trade, moving in tandem with the Asian markets. NSE Nifty moved above the 4800 mark in the opening bell. The broader market indices traded with significant gains in the beginning. Both the BSE Mid Cap and the Small Cap index started the day on a robust note. All the sectoral indices opened in green barring the Realty and FMCG index as they traded marginally lower while Metal, Consumer Durables, Capital Goods and Power stocks fronted the rally in beginning. After a positive opening, the key benchmark indices traded above the crucial 16k mark, on the back of increased inflow of foreign funds. Significant buying was witnessed among the heavyweights in the early afternoon trade also. European markets also advanced which further boosted investor confidence in our markets. But the last hour of trade witnessed significant selloff as traders resorted to profit booking. However the freefall got arrested and the markets ultimately closed above the unchanged mark. Among the sectors Metal, Oil&Gas, Consumer goods fronted the rally while Realty, FMCG, Auto stocks lagged behind.
- BSE Midcap Index ended lower 25.00 points or 0.42% to 5942.77 while Smallcap Index closed lower 10.52 points or 0.15% at 7178.95.
- NSE Nifty touched an intra-day high of 4842.20 and low of 4782.65 while BSE Sensex touched an intra-day high of 16232.16 and low of 16030.56
- Finally Nifty ended higher by 22.35 points at 4805.25 and Sensex closed higher by 107.35 points at 16123.67



- HINDALCO, STER, SBIN, RELINFRA & NATIONALUM were the major gainers where as TATAPOWER, AXISBANK, HINDUNILVR, RCOM & MARUTI were the major losers among the Nifty stocks.
- Nifty may find support at around 4765 and resistance at around 4848.
