#### **VIEW POINT: WAITING FOR THE GLOBAL CUES**

The Sensex gave up some of the early gains but clung on the rest to close the day with a gain of 73 points. The Nifty too managed a gain of 25 odd points. TCS should help the markets gain in the morning, with a better than expected quarterly performance.

The advance decline ratio was good but the volumes were considerably lower, indicating the reluctance of the players to take large positions with the US and commodity markets closed. Engineering, media and steel stocks could do well, with possibility of a downward drift later.

#### **Banking reforms**

According to Mr Prithviraj Chauhan, minister of state in the Prime Minister's Office, The Banking Regulations (Amendment) Bill as well as the long-awaited Pension Fund Development and Regulatory Authority Bill could be introduced in the Budget session to push further financial sector reforms. This he revealed in his address at a capital market conference organised by the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry.

Chavan said the amendments to the Banking Regulations Act were expected to help foreign banks acquire undercapitalised private Indian banks (read banks with less than Rs 300 cr networth). The RBI's roadmap on banking consolidation allows only "weak" banks to be acquired but the central bank has neither defined what a weak bank is nor ever identified a weak bank. The RBI's roadmap proposes to open up the banking sector to foreign banks from 2009.

#### Phoenix Lamps: SEBI directs Actis to increase open offer

The Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) has asked Actis to increase the price of open offer for the minority shareholders of Phoenix Lamps by 25 per cent to Rs 190 a share.

The open offer was made after Actis bought the entire 37 per cent stake in Phoenix Lamps from its promoters, the Gupta family. Priced at Rs 152 a share, the mandatory 20 per cent public offer was supposed to open on August 31 and close on September 19. The capital market regulator Sebi has asked Actis to pay the same price it offered to the promoters. Actis had agreed to pay Rs 190 a share to the promoters of the company, 25 per cent higher than the price of the open offer on account of non-compete fees, an agreement the market regulator did not find merit in.

#### NELP VI to be wrapped up by Jan end

With NELP VII looming round the corner, the Government is likely to hasten the completion of NELP VI.

The auction of oil blocks under the sixth round of New Exploration and Licensing Policy (NELP VI) is likely to be wrapped up by the end of January, though it was not immediately clear if the 19 controversial bids had also been approved by the Empowered Committee of Secretaries (ECS) which met for the second time on the issue today.

The committee first met on November 23 to decide on the award of 52 blocks under NELP VI but deferred a decision due to "erratic financial packages" offered for 19 blocks, where the government's share of profit petroleum started from a high of 90 per cent and tapered down to 1-2 per cent over the period of the contract.

The ECS' recommendations will now head to the Cabinet for approval. Official sources had earlier said there might be renegotiations on the 19 blocks for which the government's share was going down with time.
