VIEW POINT: TURN OF THE BULLS

The markets are likely to open sharply higher and the shoe will be on the other leg today. It is going to be turn of the bears to get trampled over and the Nifty might end the current settlement at 4400, a level, which the punters have been talking about for some time. The rally comes on the back of release of an August 27 Bernanke letter to a senator that hints at Fed will act if need be.

Meanwhile, stocks climbed the Thursday wall of worry on hopes that the central bank might act to bring down the CRR. Banking stocks could continue their rise. Never read too much into the quadruple witching day's proceedings. Carry over positions only if the next month's Nifty Futures sharply reduce the current discount.

THE INDICATOR**ACROSS THE ATLANTIC**

U.S. stocks rallied across the board Wednesday, in sharp contrast to the steep decline in the previous session, boosted by hopes of a rate cut and strong gains in technology and energy shares. Volumes were light.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** jumped 247.44 points, or 1.9%, to 13,289.29. The **S&P 500** added 31.40 points, or 2.19%, to 1463.76, and the **Nasdaq** was better by 62.52 points, or 2.5%, at 2563.16.

Chipmakers, retailers, computer hardware stocks and precious metals names were among the leaders of what was a broad-based rally.

The mood improved as investors learned that **Federal Reserve** Chairman Ben Bernanke had sent a letter to New York Sen. Chuck Schumer saying that the **central bank would "act as needed"** if the economy appeared to be imperiled by the troubles in the financial markets.

The change in direction comes a day after the minutes from the last Fed meeting failed to convince investors that an ease in interest rates was being considered.

However, the bulls interpreted the Bernanke correspondence as a sign the fed funds target rate could come down. Many market participants are looking for a cut at or before the next Fed meeting Sept. 18.

The private sector and Congress should create new, affordable mortgage products that would help some homeowners refinance their mortgages and keep their homes, Federal Reserve Chairman Ben Bernanke suggested in a letter released Wednesday.

DaimlerChrysler said its second-quarter profit fell to \$2.5 billion, or \$2.36 a share, from \$2.9 billion and \$2.80 a share a year earlier. Revenue slipped 3% to \$32.2 billion. For the year, the company expects revenue of around \$134 billion, roughly the same as 2006.

Shares of the automaker rose after DaimlerChrysler approved a buyback of 10% of its outstanding shares. Daimler gained \$3.25, or 3.9%, to \$87.59.

Elsewhere, **Altria** rose nearly 1.1% after announcing it will seek to spin off its Philip Morris International division. The company also is raising its dividend. Altria added 79 cents at \$69.86.

Away from stocks, oil prices spiked following the Energy Department's latest inventory report. The front-month October **crude** contract surged \$1.78 to close at **\$73.51** a barrel.

The Energy Department said that gasoline stocks fell by 3.6 million barrels last week. Crude stores, meanwhile, fell by a greater-than-expected 3.5 million barrels, and distillates rose 900,000 barrels.
