VIEW POINT: CARNAGE AT OPEN

Markets are likely to plunge sharply lower in opening trade Monday as we react to the Wall Street slide on Friday that saw the Dow registering the eighth largest decline in history in point terms on the back of a surging crude and outright bad employment numbers. Crude pole vaulted 11\$ to \$ 138, another record.

The Nifty that closed at 4628 on Friday may break the 4448 mark. This is the level from which the Nifty bounced back in January. In the Month of March, it came within breathing distance of 4468 but bounced back. So if Nifty breaks the level of 4448 now, it would make a lower bottom and comprehensively answer the question once and for all whether we are in a bear market. It's breaking would immediately trigger selling by all those, who had not blinked in January and March. So my advice is to protect your capital at all costs and do whatever is needed to implement this strategy.

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THE INDICATOR**AT THE STREET****BRACE FOR A CRASH LANDING**

Gentlemen and Ladies, get back to your seats, tighten your seat belts and get in to a brace mode. We are shortly going to crash land!

Courtesy the low fair airlines, which are no more their name sake, the term 'brace' is something that most of our readers would be familiar with. This is one announcement that no one would like to hear mid-air. Fortunately, this is just a warning for a sharp plunge, that may or may not materialize Monday morning as our markets re-align themselves to the world markets after a nightmarish weekend.

The Dow plunged to its largest fall in four months, plummeting 395 points, or 3.1%, to 12,210 as all 30 of its components ended with significant losses on Friday. This was the Dow's biggest one-day loss since Feb. 27, 2007. The sharp fall in the benchmark, came on the back of weak job numbers and a surging crude.

In the month of May 49,000 jobs were lost, taking the tally of job losses so far this year to 324,000. The unemployment rate, judged through another survey, jumped to 5.5% in May from 5% in April. Economists had hoped for a 0.10% rise to 5.10%. The 0.50% gain in unemployment was the highest in the last 22 years, just to give you an idea about the speed with which unemployment is rising.

Crude was the other concern. Crude oil futures for July rocketed as much as \$11.33, the biggest-ever intraday dollar move on the Nymex and equivalent to an entire barrel's price in late 1998, to a new all-time high of \$139.12 a barrel. Futures settled at \$138.54 a barrel, a surge of \$10.75, and have soared more than \$16 over the past two sessions.

The surge in crude futures Friday came amid heightened concerns that Israel might attack Iran, one of the world's largest oil producers. Morgan Stanley released a research report before the open saying that oil could easily reach \$150 a barrel by this summer due to Asia's insatiable thirst for energy and oil's new role as a hedging mechanism to protect investors from the sliding dollar. Readers are very much aware about the Goldman Sachs target of \$150- \$200 a barrel within the next 6 months to two years.

Coming back to our markets, the investors must ascertain how is crude behaving in the electronic trade on Monday morning. If it is down by about \$ 5 a barrel or more, it might help in preventing a huge sell off, though a fall in the morning is more or less certain. However, if crude does not go back into the barracks, it could spell trouble for our markets.

Readers would recall, that Nifty had bounced back from 4448 in January and though the Sensex made a low in March, which was lower than the January low, the Nifty did not. March low of Nifty at 4468 was higher than January. As one Index had made a lower bottom and one had not, those wanting to remain invested used the divided jury to make a case for continued investment.

But if the 4448 level breaks now, there would be no room for any debate that we are in a bear market. This could trigger further sale orders by all those who had showed tenacity last time, which could have a cascading effect on the markets. While possibilities always exist of a subsequent recovery, I for one would not bank on one.

Slammed hard by the soaring price of crude-oil futures, which on Friday closed at a new record high, and a rise in the jobless rate, U.S. stocks more than wiped out weekly gains, with the Dow chalking up the 8th-largest point drop in the blue-chip index's history

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** took its longest fall in four months, plummeting 394.64 points, or 3.1%, to 12,209.81, as all 30 of its components ended with significant losses. The **S&P 500** shed 43.37 points, or 3.1%, to 1360.68, and the **Nasdaq** slid 75.38 points, or nearly 3%, to 2474.56.

Wall Street was in trouble from the start, but stocks took even more of a beatdown as crude oil rocketed as much as \$11.33, the biggest-ever intraday dollar move on the Nymex, to a new all-time high of \$139.12 a barrel.

Futures settled at \$138.54 a barrel, a surge of \$10.75, and have soared more than \$16 over the past two sessions.

A confluence of factors came together to spark Friday's rampant oil bullishness, among them a statement from the European Central Bank saying there is "ample consensus" for a eurozone rate hike next month. After the **Federal Reserve's** deep interest-rate cuts over the past few months, that move would widen the spread between the U.S. dollar and the euro even more.

The smattering of economic data on tap for next week will take on new significance after crude's latest rally and Friday's **employment report**, which showed that May was the fifth-straight month of a decline in nonfarm payrolls, down 49,000. Worse yet, the unemployment rate spiked to 5.5% during the month from 5%, its largest one-month increase since 1986.

This week, the Fed will release its so-called **beige book** report on U.S. economic conditions on Wednesday, after the Census Bureau provides a tally of the U.S. trade deficit for April on Tuesday.

The Fed has an economic slowdown problem, and it's going to deal with that instead of the inflation problem because they can't raise rates at a time when things are so fragile. But inflation is clearly a problem here, and the Fed may well lose control of it."

Investors will get a fresh look at the government's main inflation gauge on Friday when it releases a report on the **consumer price index** for May. The headline figure is expected to show consumer prices up 0.5% for the month, up from 0.2% in April. Excluding food and energy prices, prices are expected to gain 0.2%, up from 0.1%.

Also Friday, the **University of Michigan** will release its preliminary **consumer sentiment index** for June. Economists are forecasting a reading of 57.5, which would mark a rebound from 51.1 in May, its lowest level since 1990.
