VIEW POINT: STAY AWAY

We were cautious yesterday and we continue to maintain the same stance. The buoyancy of the Japanese markets may help prop the markets in the morning, but we are not biting the bait. We believe that the IPOs in the pipeline will dehydrate the markets going forward, so we would advise reducing exposure if the markets do inch up in early trade.

While Gonu, a category 5 cyclone, churning the Arabian Sea with speeds of 195 miles an hour, it may be time to stay away from the markets for the time being. Gujarat and Reliance could heave a sigh of relief, but the danger now shifts to the Strait of Hormuz, the exit point for 17 million barrels of crude daily. Though there only a few offshore installations in the region, they have not seen a major cyclone for years, and so may be under prepared to face the wrath. Next crucial supports for the markets exist at 4200 for the Nifty and 14200 for the Sensex.

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At the street

Crude surges

Crude-oil futures rallied Monday, boosted by a combination of factors, including an increase in fuel demand, escalating tensions between Russia and the West, and the risk of a cyclone hitting the Persian Gulf.

Crude for July delivery closed up \$1.13 at \$66.21 a barrel on the New York Mercantile Exchange

The Energy Department measured total implied fuel demand in the U.S. at an average 20.9 million barrels in the four weeks that ended May 25. That's up 2.4% from the same period a year earlier.

Prices were also strengthened by expectations that Cyclone Gonu will hit the Persian Gulf in the next 24 hours. The U.S. Navy has warned coalition military ships in the Gulf to avoid the cyclone, Zawya

BP declared a "force majeure" on Canadian crude supply to its Whiting, Ind., plant Friday, meaning that the company cannot meet its contract requirements to purchase oil from Canadian suppliers to the refinery.

A SEVERE CYCLONE IN THE GULF

For a change, the Persian Gulf is in a brace mode. A category 5 CYCLONE GONU is paying a visit.

There is no difference between a Cyclone, Typhoon or a Hurricane, except the geography in which it take splace.

- "hurricane" (the North Atlantic Ocean, the Northeast Pacific Ocean east of the dateline, or the South Pacific Ocean east of 160E)
- "typhoon" (the Northwest Pacific Ocean west of the dateline)
- "severe tropical cyclone" (the Southwest Pacific Ocean west of 160E or Southeast Indian Ocean east of 90E)
- "severe cyclonic storm" (the North Indian Ocean)
- "tropical cyclone" (the Southwest Indian Ocean)

Leaving aside the debate of names, what is important is that the cyclone is a category 5, i.e. speeds of 156 miles or more. The Gonu has speeds of 195 miles an hour at this time and is likely to be reduced to a category 3 cyclone, i.e. speeds of 111 miles an hour by the time it makes land fall in the strait of Hormuz, the worlds most productive energy basin.

Fortunately in this region, most production is on-shore and there are not many off-shore platforms unlike Gulf of Mexico. As most facilities are onshore, the winds will weaken as they make a landfall sharply reducing their ability to bring damage to the oil facilities.

Two facilities, however, the Ras Tanura and Ras al-Juaymah oil loading platforms in Saudi Arabia, not so far in the direct line of the storm, are the ones which are susceptible to any damage, if the cyclone changes course even slightly.



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They collectively pump nearly 10 million barrels per day of crude. These facilities, while critical to global energy supplies and -- due to their size -- largely immune to terrorist attacks, are *not* particularly hurricane resistant. After all, they were built in an area where such storms are almost unheard of.

Shipping disruption be a larger menace. Right now, Gonu is on a collision course with the Strait of Hormuz, a major chokepoint that transits some 17 million bpd of crude. Within the next few hours, the tankers and supertankers -- not to mention the massive container ships that often visit regional hubs in the United Arab Emirates -- that ply that route will be scurrying out of the storm's way.

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Across the Atlantic

U.S. stocks managed to close higher Monday, after investors took news of another overnight stumble in the Shanghai stock market in stride, and a sustained stream of deal news offset rising bond yields and crude prices.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** closed up 8.21 points at 13,676.32, and the **S&P 500** was higher by 2.84 points at 1539.18. The **Nasdaq** tacked on 4.37 points to 2618.29.

Only 13 of the Dow's 30 members posted gains. Still, the pullbacks were limited. **Alcoa**, with a 1.1% decline to \$40.99, was the biggest loser. **Wal-Mart's** 3.5% increase to \$51.21 buoyed the index.

For the S&P, the climb marked its fourth straight all-time high. The Dow set a new standard for the 27th time this year.

A new day brought another series of deals, but selloffs overseas made the domestic market a bit jittery early. Europe fell after Russian's president, Vladimir Putin, said his country's missiles would be aimed at the continent if the U.S. moved ahead with plans to install an antimissile system there.

China's CSI 300 was battered again, plunging 7.7% amid reports that the nation's government isn't inclined to intervene to stop the local market's recent slump. However, Hong Kong and Tokyo both escaped the downturn and ended to the upside.

Meanwhile, mergers and acquisitions were continuing to make headlines. One pact will see **Flextronics** spend \$3.6 billion for fellow electronics manufacturer **Solectron** .

Flextronics was down 1.4% to \$11.54, while Solectron jumped 15% to \$3.88

Also in the tech sector, **Palm** is selling 25% of itself to the private-equity firm Elevation Partners, and reports indicate that TPG and Silver Lake Partners are near a deal to take over **Avaya** .

Palm surged 9.2% to \$17.57, and Avaya was up 4% at \$16.72.

On the research front, Morgan Stanley, JPMorgan, HSBC and Wachovia upgraded Wal-Mart, and Bear Stearns lifted its rating on **Sirius**

CIBC took Motorola up to sector outperformer from sector performer

The economic calendar was practically empty. One report that did come in showed that factory orders for April rose only 0.3%. Analysts surveyed by *Bloomberg* had been looking for a 0.7% increase

As for commodities, precious metals and energy futures were mixed. Oil gained \$1.13 to \$66.21 a barrel. Gold slipped 60 cents to \$676.30 an ounce.
