The markets are likely to open on a better note than with which they closed yesterday. President Obama's tax proposals were not taken that seriously by the US markets. We will not pass a judgement here and would want to listen to the IT companies as to how this would impact them.

OI increased by about Rs. 1466 Cr., the Nifty OI increased 0.43% and the premium on the Nifty Futures shed 1 point. Second rung real estate companies could further lead the charge. Among the popular stocks, Suzlon, R.Power, RNRL, IFCI, Praj saw positions being added. The large caps saw some reduction in positions. The bid of Congress yesterday to portray Rahul Gandhi as a pragmatic leader, reaching out to his political adversaries, may backfire as the entire exercise has depicted Congress as a party that has already lost hopes of winning elections.

Obama's tax proposal will hurt US interests

Obama is worried that multinational US corporations pay only fraction of the tax on their income, around 3% (according to 2004 data) in the US. Where as the domestic corporations pay 35%. The objective is to shift the jobs to US by disallowing some of the expenditure undertaken abroad.

Obama may only be harming the US interests in doing so.

Companies will no longer be competitive and will lose business.

Many Indians will lose jobs, state governments will lose local taxes and the spending power of such employees.

Some of the jobs could move onshore and would be costly for the companies.

The move will impact the foreign companies operating in India.

But there is double taxation avoidance treaty in place between India and the US. So if you take that into consideration, things become normal for these companies.

Now if you were to consider that the amount spent on outsourcing by US companies is disallowed as deductable expenditure, the cost of outsourcing jumps by 50%. If this is done, the Indian companies also get impacted.

Infosys ADR just ended 1% down. That tells you that the Silicone Valley is not taking the news seriously or is confident about its lobbying prowess in Washington.

Central bank to conduct only one LAF operation

With abundant cash in the system, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to dispense with two daily liquidity adjustment facility (LAF) operations. Instead, starting tomorrow, there will be only one LAF operation in the morning, the central bank said in a statement. The second LAF will be conducted only on reporting Fridays between 4.00 pm and 4.30 pm. It also said that other conditions for LAF operations will remain unchanged.

After the credit crisis intensified following the collapse of Lehman Brothers on September 16 last year, RBI had announced that a second LAF operation would be conducted on a daily basis to deal with the tight liquidity conditions and also to provide comfort to the market.

Insider trading: Sebi puts RIL on notice

Market regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi) is believed to have issued a show-cause notice to Reliance Industries (RIL) and its associate entities following a probe into charges of insider trading in securities of group firm Reliance Petroleum (RPL).

RIL had sold over 4 per cent equity in RPL in November 2007, prior to which heavy selling, said to be by various group entities, was noticed in the futures contract of RPL. Gains made through these transactions could be over Rs 500 crore, but no confirmation could be obtained from Sebi.

In the show-cause notice, Sebi is understood to have asked RIL and its 12 associate entities, which are said to have sold in the futures market, why action should not be taken against them under the Sebi Act and the Prevention of Fraudulent and Unfair Practices Regulation



L&T inks pact with EADS to invest in defence biz

Larsen and Toubro has tied up with Europe's EADS Defence and Security division to form a joint venture company for defence electronics in India.

The facility to be set up at Talegoan, near Pune, at a cost of Rs 100 crore will focus on design, development, manufacture and related service in electronic warfare, radar, military avionics and mobile systems (such as modular bridges). The formation of the joint venture is subject to approval of the Union Government. L&T intends to invest Rs 2,000 crore in defence-related businesses over the next three years. EADS (European Aeronautic Defence and Space Co) is a global leader in aerospace, defence and related services. In 2008, EADS generated revenues of €43.3 billion and employed over 1,18,000

Maytas Infra to raise Rs 800-1,000 crore

Maytas Infrastructure Ltd, the listed company floated by the promoters of Satyam Computer Services, plans to raise Rs 800 crore to Rs 1,000 crore through asset sales plus loan and guarantees from banks to complete various projects, including the prestigious Hyderabad Metro, and to bid for some new projects that are coming up for auction.

Sources close to the development said the company had identified the 10-km Bangalore Elevated Tollway Ltd, the Cyberabad Expressway Pvt Ltd and another project in north India for sale.

The Rs 775-crore Bangalore Elevated Tollway is already operational and the other projects are expected to be completed by the end of 2009. The company expects to raise about Rs 500 crore from one of these projects.

Satyam allots 31% shares to Tech Mahindra arm

Satyam Computer Services today announced that it allotted 300.27 million shares (31 per cent of the share capital) to Venturbay Consultants, a subsidiary controlled by Tech Mahindra, which outbid rivals in the race to acquire a controlling stake in tainted Satyam Computer.

Venturbay had on April 20 deposited into an escrow account Rs 1,756 crore (about \$351 million), the subscription amount for the shares. Conditions precedent to the allotment of the initial shares have now been satisfied by the parties and the funds have been released from the escrow to Satyam's account.

Satyam expects to use these funds for general corporate purposes including repayment of certain existing loans.

Jubilant may earn \$220 mln from AstraZeneca deal

India's Jubilant said on Tuesday its unit signed a drug research deal with Anglo-Swedish AstraZeneca, potentially earning the local firm up to \$220 million in research and milestone fees and boosting its shares.

Of this, Jubilant Organosys Ltd will get about \$20 million as a definite payment from AstraZeneca, with an annual payment of about \$3 million coming in the first two years initially

Maruti to launch 'Ritz' on May 15

India's largest car maker Maruti Suzuki on Tuesday said it will launch its new hatchback 'Ritz' May 15. "Ritz, which will be available in petrol and diesel variants, will be India's first BS-IV compliant car," the company said in a statement, referring to the Bharat Stage IV emission norms.

The car is positioned in the premium A2 market segment, which includes its compact offerings such as Alto, WagonR, Swift, Zen and the newly-launched A-Star.



Pennar Industries to Buyback 5% of its Shares

The Board of Directors of Pennar Industries Ltd at its meeting held on April 27, 2009 has considered and approved a buyback of its equity shares from existing shareholders through the Stock Exchange route, at a price not exceeding Rs 40 per share.

The buy back amount will not exceed Rs 12 crores which represents 9.74% of the total paid up Equity Share Capital and Free Reserves of the Company. The Company intends to buyback its fully paid up equity shares with a face value of Rs 5/- each to a maximum extent of 65 lakh shares and a minimum number of 10 lakh shares. The buyback offer will be valid from May 14, 2009 to April 26, 2010.

Indian Hotels buys 2.25 million shares of Orient Express

Indian Hotels, owner of the Taj Group of hotels, has bought 2.25 million shares of the New York-listed Orient Express Hotels (OEH) at \$5.75 a share, in a market transaction totalling \$12.93 million (about Rs 64.65 crore).

In a statement to the Securities Exchange Commission, Indian Hotels said its subsidiary Samsara Properties raised a \$51-million loan from the UK branch of ICICI Bank, to part fund the share purchase. Orient Express Hotels owns several luxury resorts, tourist trains and cruises.

The interest on the ICICI loan will accrue on a daily basis at a rate of Libor plus 4% per annum, said the Indian Hotels statement. According to people close to the development, the Tatas will fund the remaining amount through internal accruals. Indian Hotels officials declined to comment on the development.

ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Stocks in New York pared losses in the final hour of trading but were unable to reach positive territory on Tuesday as slight profit-taking followed Monday's rally. Investors also were looking ahead to the results of bank stress tests.

The **Dow Jones Industrial Average** fell 16.09 points, or 0.2%, to 8410.65, while the **S&P 500** edged down 3.4 points, or 0.4%, to 903.80. The **Nasdaq** gave up 9.4 points, or 0.5%, to 1754.12.

Among the positive stocks on the Dow, **Bank of America** rose 4.4% to \$10.84, followed by a 4% rise in **Kraft** and a 3.4% gain in **Citigroup**.

Fed Chairman **Ben Bernanke** testified before Congress about the central bank's efforts to encourage lending and stimulate the economy.

Bernanke said that recent data indicate the pace of contraction in the economy may be slowing, and the housing market is showing signs of bottoming, but that we are likely to see further sizable job losses and increased unemployment in coming months.

Recent data suggesting the economy is improving, or at least worsening at a slower pace, have stoked bulls and helped to extend what many have described as a long-in-the-tooth rally.

The **Institute for Supply Management** report showed a slightly better-than-expected improvement in the service sector, with the index rising to **43.7** in April from 40.8 in March. On Monday, investors were pleasantly surprised as pending home sales and construction spending picked up unexpectedly.

The most highly anticipated events of the week -- the release of the stress-test results and the latest unemployment figures -- will occur on Thursday and Friday.

About 10 of the 19 largest U.S. banks that underwent the so-called stress tests are likely to be asked to raise more capital in order to meet requirements. Earlier media reports have suggested that Bank of America, Citi, PNC Financial and also Wells Fargo are among those banks being asked to raise billions of dollars to fill holes.

Following the announcement of the results, bank holding companies will be required to develop "comprehensive capital plans" to reach the required levels and will then have six months to execute those plans "with the assurance that equity capital from the government's program will be available as needed," Bernanke said in his testimony to Congress.

Concern and criticism about the design and consequences of the so-called stress tests have been buzzing around Wall Street, but so far worries have done little to impede stocks. The KBW Bank Index surged an impressive 14.7% on Monday. It declined 1.6% on Tuesday.

In corporate news, **IBM** said it has acquired privately held software provider Exeros for an undisclosed amount. IBM shares fell 0.3% to \$105.35.

Kraft said revenue was down but profits 10% in the first quarter, and the company reaffirmed its full-year .

Crude oil, which reached a new high for the year on Monday, lost 63 cents to settle at **\$53.84** a barrel, while **gold** rose \$2.10 to **\$905.70**.
