The Fort Leavenworth Environmental Division has contracted BHE Environmental, Inc. (BHE) to prepare an Environmental Assessment (EA) of the Master Plan and ongoing mission at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas. As you may be aware, the primary mission of the Combined Arms Center at Fort Leavenworth is to provide leadership and supervision for leader development and professional military and civilian education. The installation also hosts the U.S. Army Disciplinary Barracks and several other tenant units.

Fort Leavenworth is preparing a Master Plan to guide the next several years of construction, renovation, and improvement projects that will provide the real property and infrastructure necessary to support the mission. A list of projects currently included in the Master Plan is attached; please note that development of the Master Plan is in progress and the list is subject to change. The ongoing mission of Fort Leavenworth includes operation of the infrastructure and the training, residential, recreational, and support facilities on the installation.

The EA will be prepared in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA), the guidelines of the President's Council on Environmental Quality, and 32 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 651, "Environmental Analysis of Army Actions." The EA will identify and evaluate environmental impacts of the proposed action (implementation of the Master Plan and ongoing mission). Effects of alternatives, including the No-Action Alternative (continue current operations without implementing the new Master Plan), will also be evaluated.

The purpose of this letter is to invite participation of your agency in the development of the EA. We request any information your agency may have that is pertinent to our analysis, as well as your comments on issues that you feel should be considered in the EA process. 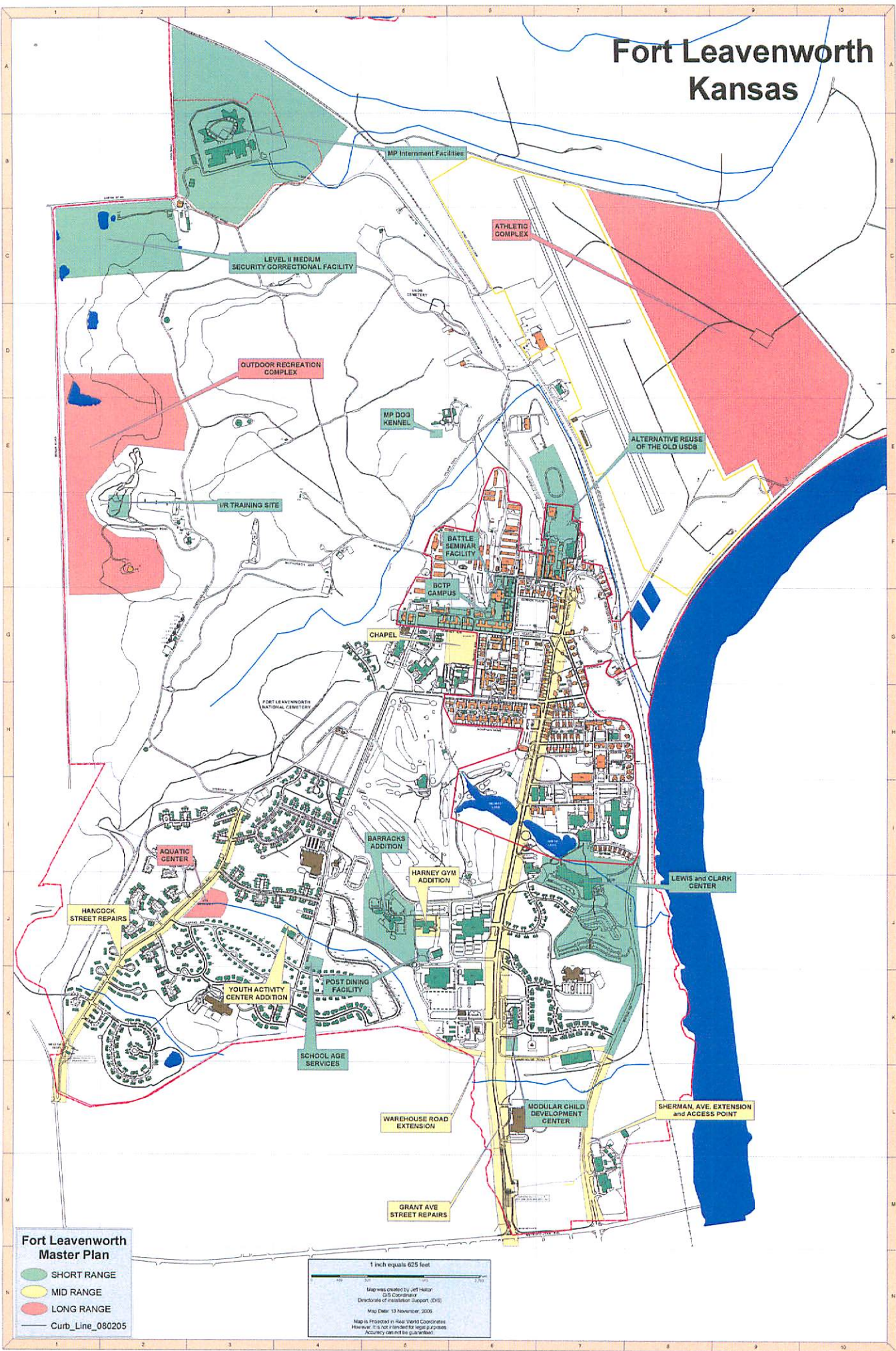
