Project proposal should be demonstrable model and will be evaluated based on

- Use of maximum recyclable material
- Any use of degradable material
- Design simplicity of complex problems
- Total estimated cost
- Ingenuity
- Involvement of the student (not the teacher)

If your project is approved by the committee then you will receive confirmation from the organizers for commencement of the project by May 15th and then on 14th June 2014, you should come and demonstrate the project at the conference to be held at Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore. Selected projects will be given 3000 Rs for the project materials in addition travel by nearest route Bus / train journey from your place to Bangalore and back.
