- Each paper will be given 10-15 minutes for presentation.
- The conference shall be held offline only.
- Registration fees shall include kit, food and conference certificate only.
- No accommodation shall be provided to the delegates.

History and Literature

Literature and history are connected mostly in the field of comparative literature. This analytical mode of study attempts to compare any two pieces of literature from different languages or cultures. For instance, the French school of thought examines literature for its historical and national basis. The German school looks for social inspirations, while the American school looks for universal truths. The Greek historians frequently combined myth and truth. Historical fiction shows the deep connections between history and literature by having the writer study a particular era from the past in order to write a story.

Psychology and Literature

"Human Psyche is the womb of all the sciences and arts." As Carl Jung has rightly proposed, the uniqueness of human psyche and its relation to literature. There are only a few ideas in the history of civilization that have had such a profound influence. Owing to Aristotle's work, the horizon of "catharsis" coalesced realms of psychology and literature. Psychological and Literal enquiries progress parallelly by acknowledging the various psychic nuances along with its contradictions and dilemmas with the help of drawing inspiration from each other, making these two disciplines mutually beneficial. Deep exploration of mysterious aspects of the human psyche provides evidence for the striking similarities between Psychology and Literature. Literature provides ground through superstitious events, adding the gothic element and completely neglecting scientific reasons. Literature contains the elements of both drama and psychology as it shows the swift transformation of intensely portrayed sentiments following the lead character's uncontrollable hunger for more, as he strives for physical gratification, manipulated by the intense stream of emotions and morally unusual thought processes.
