

15 სექტემბერს, ხობში დასუფთავდა სკვერები, სტადიონის და სასაფლაოს მიმდებარე ტერიტორიები, წმინდა სამების და ხობის მონასტრის ტერიტორიები, სულ დაახლოებით 5 ჰა ფართობი, შეგროვდა 3 მ³ ნარჩენი. დასუფთავების აქციაში მონაწილეობდნენ სხვადასხვა სოფლების მაცხოვრებლები, რომლებმაც დაასუფთავეს სოფლის ცენტრები. ხობში დასუფთავების აქციაში მონაწილეობა მიიღო 300-მდე მოხალისემ.

15 სექტემბერს, მარტვილის მუნიციპალიტეტში დასუფთავდა მარტვილის ბაზრის, სკვერების, პირველი და მეორე საბავშვო ბაღების მიმდებარე ტერიტორიები. მარტვილის ცენტრისა და კანიონის მისასვლელი გზა სულ 15 ჰა ფართობის ტერიტორია, შეგროვდა 4,5 მ³ ნარჩენი, მონაწილეობდა 50-მდე ადამიანი.

დასუფთავების აქციები სამეგრელო ზემო-სვანეთის მხარეში ჩატარდა პროექტის - „დავასუფთაოთ საქართველო-ფაზა III“ ფარგლებში, რომელსაც ახორციელებს არასამთავრობო ორგანიზაციათა კონსორციუმი – „საქართველოს მწვანეთა მოძრაობა/დედამიწის მეგობრები-საქართველო, საქართველოს ბუნების მკვლევართა კავშირი „ორქისი“ და „ეკოლოგიური ცნობიერების ამაღლება და ნარჩენების მართვა“. პროექტი ხორციელდება შვედეთის მთავრობის ფინანსური უზრუნველყოფით, გარემოს დაცვისა და ბუნებრივი რესურსების სამინისტროს მხარდაჭერით.

"Clean Up the World - Clean Up Georgia!"

In the framework of international clean-up campaign "Clean up the World" in Georgia, large-scale clean-up activities were carried out in Samegrelo- Upper Svaneti region. The event was organized by the local coordinator of the Greens Movement of Georgia / Friends of the Earth-Georgia, with support of local governing bodies.

September 15 - in "Clean Up the World " campaign were involved all villages of Zugdidi municipality, with participation of local population. As part of the action 48 territorial centers of the villages, Anaklia - Ganmukhuri coastline, Gulua park, central alley, botanical garden, Chkhov river bank, 1200 homestead yards of local residents were cleaned up, a total of 123 ha area. Around 107 m³ of waste was collected with participation of 2550 local residents.

September 15 -In Tsalenjikha municipality during the campaign were cleaned up the central park, thoroughfare drainage channel and central stadium adjacent areas, river Chanistskali shoreline, the church and market surrounding territories. Totally, 2 ha area was cleaned up, 4 m³ of waste was collected and around 240 volunteers took part in the action.

September 15 - In Chkhorotsku municipality were cleaned up Culture and Recreation Park and its environs, adjacent areas of high-rise buildings of Chavchavadze street, the central market and stadium neighboring areas - a total area of 3.0 hectares, 24 m³ of waste were collected. The action was attended by local officials of the municipality and local population, about 150 people.



September 15 – in the framework of the action were cleaned up Mulakhi section of Mestia municipality, Margiani Street and centre of borough Mestia. In total, 1.2 ha area was cleaned up and 18 m³ of waste were collected. Around 65 local residents took part in the action.

September 15 -Organized cleaning actions were held in Abasha municipality, with participation of 350 local residents. During the action were cleaned up the city center, so called black market area, motorway adjacent territory, village centers of Abasha municipality, yards of production and service industries. Around 8 hectares of area was cleaned up and 7 m³ of waste was collected.

September 15 - In Senaki municipality has been cleaned up Senaki music school, health center and sports center surrounding areas, as well as central parks and railway station adjacent area, including shoreline of the river Tekhura. Around 1.5 hectares of area was cleaned up and 6 m³ of waste was collected, with participation of 50 volunteers.

September 15 - In Khobi, during the action were cleaned up the squares, stadium and cemetery neighborhoods, Holy Trinity Church and Khobi Monastery areas. About 5 hectares of land has been cleaned up and 3 m³ of waste was collected. Residents of different villages participated in clean-up activities that cleared the centers of the settlements. Up to 300 volunteers participated in clean-up campaign in Khobi.

September 15 – In Martvili municipality, during the action were cleaned up Martvili market, environs of N1 and N2 kindergartens, Martvili centre and Canyon access road totaled 15 hectares of area. About 4m³ of waste was collected with participation of 50 volunteers.

Clean Up actions in Samegrelo-Upper Svaneti Region has been organized in the framework of the project “Clean Up Georgia” (Phase III) implemented by NGO consortium the Greens Movement of Georgia/Friends of the Earth Georgia, Georgian Society of Nature Explorers “Orchis”, “Ecological Awareness and Waste Management” with financial support of the Government of Sweden and in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources Protection of Georgia.
