

Gamify Literacy & Wellbeing - Grades 6-12

Gamify writing, engagement, and Social-Emotional learning with an online book-creating dashboard that scaffolds students to interview others and collect oral stories, using speech-to-text and contributions. Students communicate and connect with their family, peers and community to easily create original, valuable books that can be graded, included in portfolios, gifted and sold for school fundraising.

[COVID-19 & Me](#) - Teachers automatically collect student's stories into a Collaborative Class book.

[My Family's Favourite Recipes Book](#) - Students collect their family's cultural food stories and photos.

[My Granddad's Memoir](#) - Students collect precious family stories, experiences and ancestry information.

[My Town's History](#) - Students collect oral histories from their community, developing empathy and EQ.

Fun Activities:

Students use technology-as-a-tool to structure interviewing one or many people about their lives, experiences & perspectives. Template questions guide and speech-to-text captures the oral stories into the student's automatically formatted digital book. Students invite others to contribute stories, ancestry information and photos directly into their book, to quickly collate a lot of original, precious content into a modern format.



Engage & Motivate:

Students achieve personalized & differentiated learning & can present their collected audio stories and text in the classroom for fun story-sharing and collaborative editing exercises. Developing empathy and expanding their worldview.

Student's collected content enriches lessons, especially Writing, History, Social Studies and Technology, and they are more motivated to learn when the content is their personal stories.



Create & Share:

Students are proud to present their polished book to their families at school celebration ceremonies. Books can be graded, included in their portfolios for reflection and higher education applications, gifted or printed-on-demand and sold for fundraising.

Assessment:

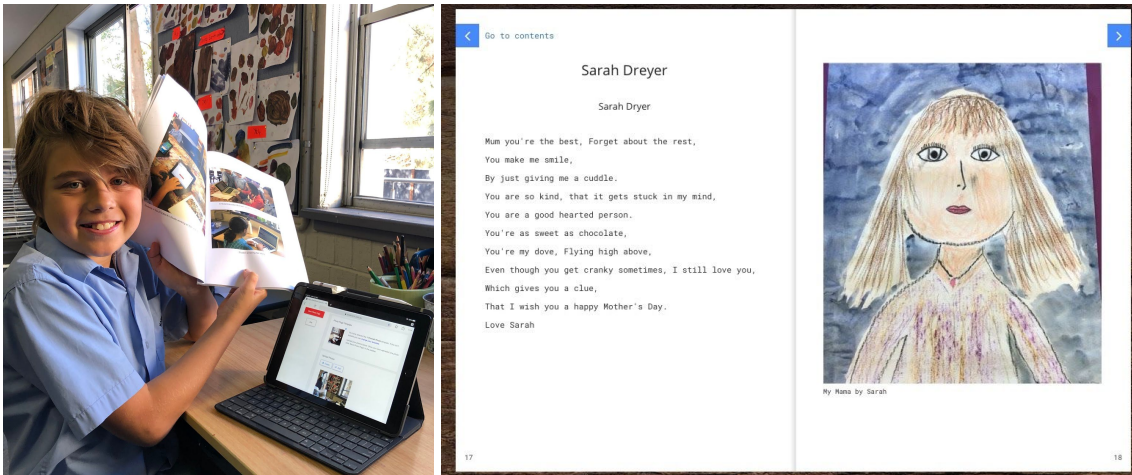
Teachers easily assign through Google Classroom to a whole class or year group or send the unique link via email. Available on Chromebooks & any device.

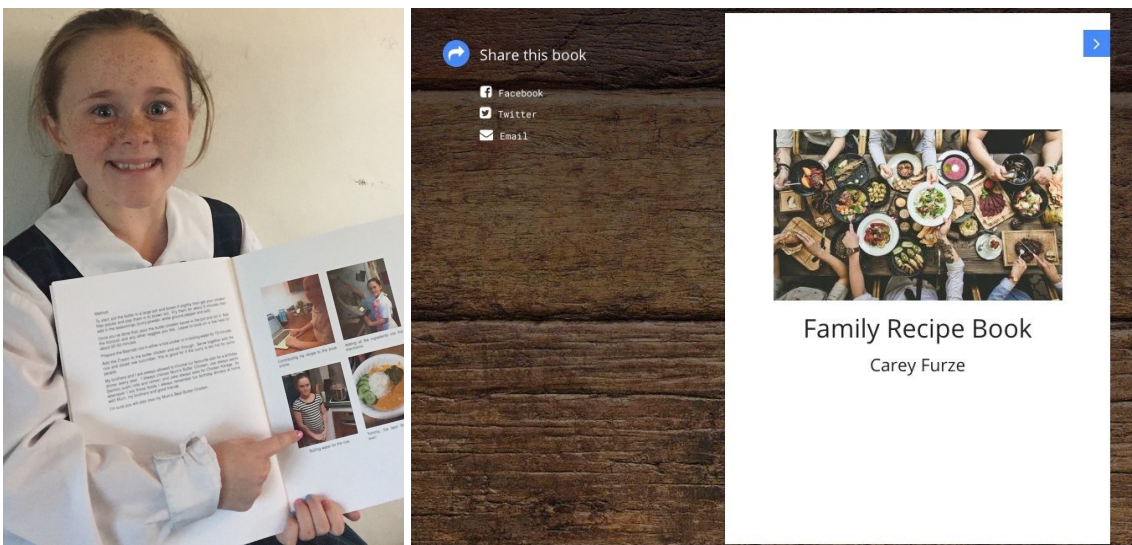
Collaborative Class Book - Grade 6-8
