6) To Investigate and Produce a Public, Numerically-Based Report Detailing the Repeated Direct, Proximal Causal Influences of Maine Municipal Association's Established Policies and Repeated Practices Upon the Concentration and Diversity of Maine Individual and Maine Group Insurance Offerings, as Shown by the Herfindahl–Hirschman Index in 2010, That Have and Are Resulting in Inhibiting, Thwarting, and Blocking Individuals and Groups From Creating New Businesses In Maine;

7) To Investigate and Produce a Public, Numerically-Based Report Detailing the Repeated Direct, Proximal Causal Influences of Maine Municipal Association's Established Policies and Repeated Practices Upon the Concentration and Diversity of Maine Individual and Maine Group Insurance Offerings, as Shown by the Herfindahl–Hirschman Index in 2010, That Have and Are Resulting in Inhibiting, Thwarting, and Blocking Individuals and Groups Engaged in Interstate Commerce From Creating New Businesses or Adding New Locations In Maine; 8) To Investigate and Produce a Public, Numerically-Based Report Detailing the Repeated Direct, Proximal Causal Influences of Maine Municipal Association's Established Policies and Procedures, Using Public Money in Repeated Violations of State and Federal Laws, to Unduly and Unfairly Influence Citizens in Maine On How to Vote in Specific Statewide Referenda, Using Tax Dollars to Defeat or Support Referenda Against the Interests of Measurable, Substantial, and Material Numbers of Citizens, Thus Contaminating and Negating the Democratic Process in Maine;

9) To Investigate and Produce a Public, Numerically-Based Report on Facts Filed in Federal Court (Mary Adams, et al. v. Maine Municipal Association, 2010, District Court, Maine, 1:10-cv-258-JAW) by Private Maine Citizens and the Maine Heritage Policy Center Versus Maine Municipal Association For Repeated Misuse of Public Funds to Influence Maine Referendum Elections to Determine Appropriate Criminal Prosecutions;

10) To Complete All Investigations and Publish Reports Within 180 Days of the Date of This Completed Petition.
