Market Wrap-Up

The benchmark Nifty and the Sensex impelled above the crucial 5800 and 19000 mark ahead of the cabinet meet that is anticipated to discuss the FDI in insurance and pension among other key issues, and the appreciation in INR along with sustained foreign funds inflow aided the markets on the penultimate day of trade. Global markets however witnessed an assorted day of trade ahead of policy meeting by the euro area's central bank amid speculation on the timing of a Spanish bailout. Nifty ended the day at 5787.60 with healthy gains of 56.35 points and the Sensex accumulated 188.46 points that parked the index at 19058.15—their highest levels in 17 months. Broader indices flouted to underperform the benchmark, clocking gains of close to half a percentage point.

Domestic Update

- The Opposition is already up in arms against more reforms by the UPA government as the Cabinet is expected to clear 26% FDI in pension and raise the cap in insurance to 49%. The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is opposed to raising the FDI cap in insurance. The party has no objections with the 26% cap, but is against raising it.
- Asia will be the engine of world economic growth with countries in the region being important participants in their "own way", Urban Development Minister Kamal Nath said.
- India's services sector expanded at its fastest pace in seven months as a spurt in new business encouraged firms to hire more staff, suggesting the worst of the economic slump may be over. The HSBC purchasing manager's index for the services sector, which gauges the activity of hundreds of Indian companies, rose to 55.8 in September from 55 in August.
- Gujarat Chief Minister Narendra Modi hit back at Congress President Sonia Gandhi after her comments in Rajkot and said that the Congress was trying to cheat the people of Gujarat and will not be forgiven.
- Petrol price may be cut by about Rs 1.60 per litre later this month as appreciation of rupee against the US dollar has helped state firms make profit on the fuel. Indian rupee appreciated to five-month high since the government announced allowing foreign direct investment (FDI) in multibrand retailing.

Sector Update

- Oil India Ltd and Indian Oil Corp have jointly bought a 30 percent stake in Houston-based Carrizo Oil & Gas's Niobrara shale asset in Colarado for USD 82.5 million. Oil India will acquire 20 percent and Indian Oil Corp will get 10 percent in Carrizo's Niobrara basin acreage assets through their respective subsidiaries. The total investment for the two companies would be around USD 82.5 million.
- A chargesheet has been filed against BJP MLA, G Somasekhara Reddy, brother of arrested mining baron, G Janardhana Reddy and 13 others in connection with the alleged threat to the life of a top forest official investigating illegal mining in the district. The 125 page charge sheet has named Somasekhara Reddy as the main accused.
- The scramble to raise funds from overseas markets is now apparent among Indian infrastructure companies. Indian Railways Finance Corporation (IRFC) is the latest to join the bandwagon raising \$300 million through dollar denominated five-year bonds.

Corporate Update

- Tata Power is looking for coal assets in the United States, Colombia and Africa. Tata Power's total generation capacity stands at 6,099 MegaWatts.
- With stalemate over salary disbursement of employees continuing, the Kingfisher Airline management may have to extend its lockdown until October 7, 2012.
- TDSAT issued notice to **Bharti Airtel** over a petition filed by Asergis
 Telecom Services, alleging that the leading private operator had blocked its
 toll free Intelligent Network (IN services) number leased from Tata
 Teleservices.
- Indiabulls Group has entered into an agreement with Qatar's Doha Bank for offering mortgage loans to latter's NRI customers for acquiring properties in India.
