#### Market Wrap-Up

Marginally mounting onto preceding session's gains of about a percent, markets meagerly edged up to clock gains of about one tenths of a percent ahead of the Federal Open Market Committee's (FOMC) meet outcome. Global indices marked a choppy session as investor's awaited Federal Reserve announcement that may initiate a new round of bond buying. Markets ended the day a tad above prior session's close with the Nifty and the Sensex parking at 5435.35 and 18921.16—clambering scantily 4.35 points and 21.13 points respectively. Broader indices however ended in the negative terrain with loss of about a quarter percentage point. Sectoral indices witnessed an assorted day of trade parking in the range of about 0.5-(1) %.

#### **Domestic Update**

- The Full Planning Commission is all set to approve the 12th Plan document that seeks to raise the average annual economic growth during the five-year period ending March 2017 to 8.2% from 7.9% achieved in the previous Plan. The meeting which has been called by Prime Minister Manmohan Singh, will also vet various other social sector targets relating to poverty alleviation, infant mortality, enrolment ratio and job creation. Besides other things, the 12th Plan seeks to achieve 4% agriculture sector growth during the Plan period.
- Amid declining industrial growth, the government said that several policy measures will be taken to arrest the slowdown and boost investments.
- Prime Minister Manmohan Singh said media should avoid the desire to be sensational and exercise restraint so that nothing that divides society and country is written, broadcast or telecast.
- The Inter Ministerial Group (IMG) on coal block allocation has been asked to conclude its work without delay and give its recommendations at the earliest.

### **Sector Update**

- The recent ban on mining imposed by Goa government and subsequently suspension of environment clearances (EC) of all the 93 mining leases in Goa by the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) is likely to adversely impact iron ore exports from India during the current fiscal.
- Competition Appellate Tribunal served notices to the Competition Commission and the Builders Association of India, on whose complaint the fair trade regulator had imposed a penalty of Rs 6,307 crore on 11 cement firms on charges of cartelization.
- The cabinet will consider a proposal to allow foreign airlines to buy stakes in local carriers on Friday, but a proposal to allow foreign supermarkets to invest in Asia's third largest economy is not on the agenda, the trade minister said.

#### Corporate Update

- SpiceJet has held "preliminary discussions" with a Gulf airline for potential
  investment in the Indian budget carrier. Any such tie-up depends on a
  policy shift in India's aviation industry, which currently prohibits foreign
  direct investment (FDI) in the sector.
- Tata Power is in talks with Bahrain-based Al Hayat Group for buying oil
  blocks in the country. The deal value is likely to be between Rs 1,400 crore
  and Rs 1,600 crore. The Al Hayat Group is looking for partners for oil blocks
  in Bahrain. The deal may be conducted by Tata Petrodyne via the joint
  venture route.
- Idea Cellular has raised prepaid tariffs by 20% in Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh. Accordingly, tariff now stands at 1.2 paise per 2 seconds and all Idea acquisitions post September 7 are being offered new rates.
- Godrej Properties would invest up to Rs 600 crore in developing a residential complex in Gurgaon over the next five years. The project Godrej Summit, will be developed in partnership with Zara Sanya under an area sharing agreement, in which GPL will hold 65% stake. This is company's second project in the National Capital Region.
- Glenmark Pharmaceuticals has entered the phase II clinical trials for its new drug molecule aimed at treating ulcerative colitis.
- Iron ore prices has fallen to Rs 5,500 per tonne but NMDC in India is charging over Rs 6,000 per tonne based on its demand-supply model.
