GUIDELINES TO WRITE A LETTER OF MOTIVATION

This letter must be adressed to the professor or supervisor of your desired department. It should be written in English or in the native language of your chosen country.

The letter should be personal and include at least the following points:

- What is your interest in your chosen project/clerkship?
- What do you expect from your project/clerkship?
- What would you like to do during your project/clerkship?
- Do you have any practical experience? (laboratory work, medical practice in hospital etc.) Theoretical knowledge?
- Why do you want to do your research/clerkship abroad in that particular country?

Focus on the attributes of the project/clerkship and not attributes of the land you will be travelling to.

Always think about what would be of interest to the professor in your country to get a brief idea of the paticipant.
