ERC WORK PROGRAMME 2023

ERC (European Research Council) is a public body for funding of scientific and technological research conducted within the European Union (EU).

Researchers from any field can compete for the grants that support pioneering projects. The ERC competitions are open to top researchers also from outside the union. Grant applications are assessed by qualified experts.

Excellence is the sole criterion for selection; there are neither thematic priorities, nor geographical quotas for funding. The aim is to recognise the best ideas, and confer status and visibility to the best research in Europe, while also attracting talent from abroad.

• Visegrad Fund

Visegrad+ Grants support projects which contribute to the democratization and transformation processes in selected countries of the Western Balkans (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia) and the Eastern Partnership regions (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine).

- Projects must develop meaningful cooperation and ensure active involvement of at least 3 V4 countries and 1 entity from the EaP region or the Western Balkans countries at minimum, regardless of the applicant
- Visegrad+ Grants should be implemented in the EaP or WBs region, and/or have a strong impact on local communities in at least one of those countries
- Maximum duration of project implementation is 18 months
- 7 focus areas: **Culture and Common Identity, Education and Capacity Building, Innovation, R&D, Entrepreneurship, Democratic Values and the Media, Public Policy and Institutional Partnership, Regional Development, Environment and Tourism, Social Development**

COST | EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY



The European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) provides international research funding for researchers to set up their interdisciplinary research networks in Europe and beyond. These bottom-up networks run for 4 years and help to build capacity.

Through these networks, the so-called COST Actions, COST provides funds for organising meetings, training schools, short term scientific missions or other networking activities in a wide range of scientific topics. This way it promotes global networking of national-funded research.

Participants are invited to submit COST Action proposals contributing to the scientific, technological, economic, cultural or societal knowledge advancement and development of Europe. Multi- and interdisciplinary proposals are encouraged.

CULTURAL HERITAGE PRESERVATION



The AFCP Grants Program supports the preservation of archaeological sites, historic buildings and monuments, museum collections, and forms of traditional cultural expression, such as indigenous languages and crafts.

Appropriate project activities may include:

- **Anastylosis** (reassembling a site from its original parts)
- **Conservation** (addressing damage or deterioration to an object or site)
- **Consolidation** (connecting or reconnecting elements of an object or site)
- **Documentation** (recording in analog or digital format the condition and salient features of an object, site, or tradition)
- **Inventory** (listing of objects, sites, or traditions by location, feature, age, or other unifying characteristic or state)
- **Preventive Conservation** (addressing conditions that threaten or damage a site, object, collection, or tradition)
- **Restoration** (replacing missing elements to recreate the original appearance of an object or site, usually appropriate only with fine arts, decorative arts, and historic buildings)
- **Stabilization** (reducing the physical disturbance of an object or site)
