HOP ON FACILITY



The Hop On Facility is based on Article 20 (3) of the HE Common Understanding providing that the work programme may foresee the possibility for legal entities from low R&I performing countries to join already selected collaborative R&I actions, subject to the agreement of the respective consortium and provided that legal entities from such countries are not yet participating in it. The scheme further aims at achieving the Inclusiveness ambition of the future ERA policy by involving research institutions from widening countries under Horizon Europe Pillar 2 actions.

Main selection criteria are excellence and added value of the new partner performing a relevant additional task in the project. All consortium partners need to agree on the accession of the new partner whereas the R&I relevance and complementarity needs to be demonstrated.

ERC (European Research Council) is a public body for funding of scientific and technological research conducted within the European Union (EU).

Researchers from any field can compete for the grants that support pioneering projects. The ERC competitions are open to top researchers also from outside the union. Grant applications are assessed by qualified experts.

Excellence is the sole criterion for selection; there are neither thematic priorities, nor geographical quotas for funding. The aim is to recognise the best ideas, and confer status and visibility to the best research in Europe, while also attracting talent from abroad.

Chemical Security Improvement Grants

On behalf of the U.S. Department of State's Chemical Security Program (CSP), CRDF Global is pleased to offer grants to improve the physical and procedural security of chemical laboratories and facilities. These Chemical Security Improvement Grants (CSIG) contribute to the security of industrial and academic chemical facilities, including their employees and their communities, and aim to prevent the accidental or intentional misuse of chemicals. CSIGs are one-time awards ranging from \$2,000 to \$30,000 in value with applications accepted on a quarterly basis. To be considered for a security improvement grant, applicants must submit a completed CSIG application form, CSIG budget form and curriculum vitae (CV) for each individual compensated under the project.

SAN DIEGO CENTER FOR AIDS RESEARCH



The International Core offers Pilot grants to investigators in seven countries.

Pilot grant recipients gain financial support for their studies and discounts on many SD CFAR resources. In return, the International Core expects grant recipients to successfully apply for subsequent grant funding and to publish manuscripts related to their SD CFAR-supported research. Continued NIAID funding of the International Core will be primarily determined by the subsequent scientific productivity of Pilot grant recipients. As of 2019, more than \$54 million have been awarded in subsequent grants.

VISEGRAD+ GRANTS

Visegrad+ Grants support projects which contribute to the democratization and transformation processes in selected countries of the Western Balkans (Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo*, North Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia) and the Eastern Partnership regions (Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine).

- Projects must develop meaningful cooperation and ensure active involvement of at least 3 V4 countries and 1 entity from the EaP region or the Western Balkans countries at minimum, regardless of the applicant
- Visegrad+ Grants should be implemented in the EaP or WBs region, and/or have a strong impact on local communities in at least one of those countries
- Maximum duration of project implementation is 18 months
- 7 focus areas: **Culture and Common Identity, Education and Capacity Building, Innovation, R&D, Entrepreneurship, Democratic Values and the Media, Public Policy and Institutional Partnership, Regional Development, Environment and Tourism, Social Development**

COST | EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY



The European Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST) provides international research funding for researchers to set up their interdisciplinary research networks in Europe and beyond. These bottom-up networks run for 4 years and help to build capacity.

Through these networks, the so-called COST Actions, COST provides funds for organising meetings, training schools, short term scientific missions or other networking activities in a wide range of scientific topics. This way it promotes global networking of national-funded research.

Participants are invited to submit COST Action proposals contributing to the scientific, technological, economic, cultural or societal knowledge advancement and development of Europe. Multi- and interdisciplinary proposals are encouraged.
