Social Entrepreneurship is the process of pursuing innovative solutions to social problems. Just as business entrepreneurs create and transform the whole industry, social entrepreneurs act as society's change agents, seizing opportunities. In contrast, others miss to improve systems, invent and disseminate new approaches, and advance sustainable solutions that create social value. The field of social entrepreneurship is receiving increased attention across the globe as a prominent approach to achieving sustainable development. Although social entrepreneurship concepts and studies have been around for more than 20 years, they have only recently become more popular due to the increased focus on achieving sustainable development targets. All social sector players must now collaborate in order to achieve the 169 targets and the 17 goals.

Objectives

This course's purpose is to introduce learners to the subject of social entrepreneurship with a focus on how social entrepreneurs influence and effect change in order to achieve sustainable development goals. The specific objectives of the program are as follows:

1. Be exposed to social entrepreneurship, successful cases, significant players, discourses, organizations, theories, and tools currently in use.

2. Participants can create and demonstrate ways of recognizing social opportunities, mobilizing resources, managing risks, scaling impact, and sustaining viable ventures.

3. Participants can assess the skills required for a future career in the field of social entrepreneurship and are aware of their social responsibility
