

## Tips For Getting Pass Marks at English

All the students are not same. I know many are brilliant students. Many of you may be working hard and getting good marks in exam. Some of you may not be working hard but still manages to get marks. And also there will be a few of you who study well but still not able to pass the exam. Don't worry my dear students. Here are some very simple tips by following which you can pass the class X board exams very easily and comfortably.

- **Never fear or hate exam.**

Some students study but may be much afraid while writing the exam. Due to this reason they get distracted and won't be able to score marks so leave all your fears and free your mind before starting the study.

- Follow your teacher's instructions.

- Attempt / Write the answers for all the three comprehension passages given in the paper 1

You can easily score 5 on 5 in the unknown passage [Q. No. 47-51] Even if you can't write the exact answer, copy down the few lines which has that answer.

- Attempt the question based on finding out the true statements which carries 3 marks.

Remember write the letters only of the true statements.

- Also attempt the questions based on the third passage. This is a multiple choice question. You can score the full marks.

- In paper 1 of English pronunciation and Rhyming words are also easy to score.

- Don't forget to attempt [1-8] questions of section A based on prose and poetry.

If you do not know any answer do not leave that question keep the question No and write what you remember from that lesson or at least the name of the lesson and the author or poet. This is very essential when you are failing by 3 – 4 marks because marks will be allotted if you write Something in the Q / Ans.

- After attempting the above bits do not give back the paper because you don't know any grammar. But attempt all the bits.
- Keep in mind that you are writing the exam for you to prove yourself. You can also score marks if you remember few important meanings and parts of speech. The following words are always.

Prepositions: of, with, to, up, in, on, by, over, into.

Conjunction: and, but, or, because.

Pronouns: he, she, it, they, we, us, them, you, I.

Verbs: is, was, are, am, were, have.

## **Paper- II**

- Don't forget the three letters in paper II, follow the pattern of the three letters.  
In the incident based letters [ Informal and Editorial ] copy down the given incident in the body of the letter if you cannot write on your own.

- Attempt the two comprehension passages given from supplementary I and II.
- Finally write and present well.

Presentation of the paper is the major factor that affects your marks.

Try to write neatly, if it is not good enough, don't worry, if you have presented neatly you can score more marks because the teachers can at least read what you have written.

Believe in God, Believe in you.

- Your mind should be free at least 5 minutes before exam.
- Pray can give energy and peace of mind.
- Don't discuss soon after the coming out of the exam. This may affect your coming exam.
