Dear Harmony Property Owners,

The time has arrived for the Class "A" Owners to elect a board member to the Board of Directors as required by Section 3.5(a) of the Bylaws of the Harmony Residential Owners Association, Inc. (HROA). Class "A" Owners include residents and builders, but not the developer. The election will be held by mail as required by Section 3.4(b) of the Bylaws. A filing period of July 27, 2015 through August 17, 2015 has been designated as the time frame for interested parties to submit their intent to be a candidate for the election.

If you are interested in being a candidate, simply complete the enclosed Intent to be a Candidate form and mail it to the community manager before the end of the filing period. Submittal must be by mail whereupon you will receive a receipt of notice from the community manager. If you submit an Intent to be a Candidate form and do not receive a receipt, please call Cheryl Chase at 407-891-2602 to confirm she has your information.

Upon the closing of the candidate filing period, the information for all candidates will be mailed to the HROA membership with an accompanying ballot. The ballot with your vote must be mailed to and received by the HROA on or before September 9, 2015. The ballots will then be counted the following day, September 10, at a duly noticed board meeting. **Be sure to watch your mail during the last week of August for a letter from your association which will include all candidate information, a ballot, and further information regarding the very important board meeting on September 10, 2015.**

The HROA board presently consists of five board members, all of which are developer appointed. Two of the board members are homeowners and the other three are developer representatives. Following this election, there will still be five board members consisting of four developer appointed members and one elected by the Class "A" Owners.

In addition to the election of a board member, the Class "A" Owners are also electing a resident member who will serve on the Members Advisory Committee (MAC) that will be formed in the near future. The candidate with the second highest votes in the board election will serve on this committee alongside the two resident HROA board members. The MAC will be a three member committee that will assist the Board in the continued effective operations of the association.

This is a very exciting time in the growth of the Harmony community. Please be sure to take the time to be informed and to be involved in the election of your board and committee members.
