  - b) Need to create user with access from host (for vagrant box):

sudo -H -u root mysql -hlocalhost uroot mysql -e "GRANT ALL ON \*.\* to root@'10.10.10.1' IDENTIFIED BY 'root'; FLUSH PRIVILEGES;"

- Phpmyadmin (installation on server)
- Sequel Pro (OS X)

- Need both Actor\_\* and Repository\_\* tables
- actor.parent\_id = 6
- Actor\_\* has fields common to repositories and authority records
- Repository\_\* has additional fields such as opening hours

## Update queries



- Backup the db (and know how to restore!)
- Probably best for cleanup affecting only one table at a time (relationships can get messy)
- Rebuild search index afterwards
