Margin settings: top 2cm, bottom 2.5cm, inner 3cm, outer 1.5cm, distance from edge to header 1.3cm, from edge to footer 1.9cm. Style: Normal, font: Times New Roman (Cyr) 13pt, paragraph indent 7.5mm, line spacing 0.85.

Microsoft Office embedded Equation Editor v. 3.0. should be used for typing formulas. Fonts: Text - Times New Roman (Cyr), Function - Times New Roman (Cyr), italic, Variable - Times New Roman (Cyr), italic, L.C.Greek - Symbol, Italic, Symbol - Symbol, italic, Matrix/Vector - Times New Roman (Cyr), Number - Times New Roman (Cyr). Sizes: Full - 12, Subscript/Superscript - 7, Sub-Subscript/Superscript - 4, Symbol - 18, Sub-Symbol - 12. It is recommended to separate formulas with spacing of 6pt before and after paragraph for better visualization.

Pictures insert: copy to clipboard, then select "Edit". "Paste Special" and select "Picture": Times New Roman (Cyr), 12pt, without paragraph indent, alignment center, line spacing 0,85).

Order of the material:

- put UDC left in the top row: (Times New Roman (Cyr), 13pt, without paragraph indent, alignment left, line spacing 1);

- print in the middle of the next line in capital letters of the paper title (Arial (Cyr), 14pt, bold italic, capital, without paragraph indent, centre alignment, spacing before and after paragraph 9pt, line spacing 1);

- one emptying line, print with lowercase letters names and surnames of author(s) (Times New Roman (Cyr), 13pt, bold italic, without paragraph indent, centre alignment, line spacing 1);

- print through a line the title organization name, its full postal address, e-mail address (Times New Roman (Cyr), 13pt, italic, without paragraph indent, centre alignment, line spacing 0,85);

- from the next line and indented is main paper text (11 pt);

- insert formulas and figures into the text to the center;
- at the end of the paper there should be listed name, surname, academic degree, academic rank, position and organization of each paper author.

- abstracts in Russian and English up to 10 lines including paper title and author name(s).

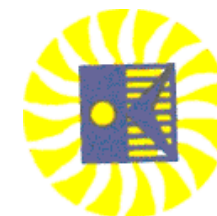
