Regional Canvass Managers will be responsible for executing the statewide field plan and supervising paid canvass operations within his/her assigned region. A Regional Canvass Manager will be based in La Crosse, Eau Claire, Wausau, and Oshkosh. All Regional Canvass Managers will report to the State Canvass Director.
