- Prepare written reports, meetings summaries, and related materials as required.
- Ability to implement a comprehensive, data-driven field plan and train, coach, and manage a field team to execute the plan
- Set, meet, and exceed benchmarks for voter contact, volunteer recruitment, grassroots engagement, and GOTV
- Responsible for managing and evaluating the UnifiEd community project plans, working with the UnifiEd Education Engagement Coordinators to facilitate the community groups
- Clearly define project roles and responsibilities, determine necessary resources, and monitor project performance through appropriate systems and procedures.
