Organising Authority: Waiuku Yacht Club, Waiuku

1.0 RULE

- 1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing
- 2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 3. For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

2. ADVERTISING

2.1 The Organising Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising

3.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 All class legal J14 boats are eligible.
- 3.2 J14 Class Measurement

Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and display a 2022-2023 WOF sticker on its transom.

Measurement and WOF checks will be available at agreed measurement times; prebooked with the Class Measurer.

All beach trailers/trolleys must have boat names and/or numbers clearly marked on them.

All Boats should have their sail number clearly marked on them.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the official entry form below accompanied by the entry fee by Wednesday 22 March 2023.

6.1 The racing area is the Waiuku estuary

7.0 THE COURSE

7.1 The courses will be triangles, or triangle, windward.

8.0 SCORING

- 8.1 The scoring system will be the low points system
- 8.2 Three races will be required to be completed to constitute a series
- 8.3 When fewer than 5 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores.
- When 5 to 7 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the worst score.
- When more than 7 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of race scores excluding the 2 worst scores.

9.0 INSURANCE

9.1 Each participating boat is encouraged to have insurance cover.

10.0 PRIZES

10.1 1st Single Handed Trophy

1st Double Handed Trophy

1st Handicap Trophy

Overall and National Champion (Salad Bowl) – Awarded to the crew with the lowest points.

1st Club Team (Munted Mermaid) -Awarded to the Team representing and affiliated yacht club whose three (3) boats combined overall points total the lowest.

Furthermost travelled crew

Oldest crew- Combined age of a 2 person crew

Youngest crew- Combined age of a 2 person crew.

11.0 PRIVACY WAIVER

11.1 In participating in the regatta, a competitor grants the organising authority and the sponsors the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion any motion picture, still picture and live taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the event.
