## Omics and Precision Medicine in Asthma

Dr. Juan C. Celedón is the ATS president for the 2020-21 term. Dr. Celedón earned a degree in medicine from Javeriana University in Colombia and a doctoral degree in public health from Harvard University. He completed a residency in Internal Medicine at Beth Israel Medical Center in New York, a Fellowship in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at Brown University, and a Research Fellowship at the Channing Laboratory of Brigham and Women's Hospital and Harvard Medical School. In 2000, he joined the faculty at Harvard Medical School, rising to Associate Professor before joining the University of Pittsburgh in 2010.

Dr. Celedón's research has focused on asthma, COPD, and health disparities in airway diseases. His scientific contributions have been acknowledged through his election to the American Society for Clinical Investigation and the Association of American Physicians, as well as through the ATS Recognition Award for Scientific Accomplishments, among other honors. A devoted mentor, he was the first faculty member to ever receive both the Young Mentor Award and the A. Clifford Barger Excellence in Mentoring Award from Harvard Medical School.
