

Red Bull Soapbox Race Official Rules

1 <u>Soapboxes</u>

- a. All soapbox racers must be human powered, meaning no engines, peddles or external energy sources.
- b. Pre-fabricated cars are not accepted!
- c. Dimensions of craft must be:
 - i. Less than 6 ft. wide.
 - ii. Less than 6 ft. tall.
 - iii. Less than 12 ft. in length.
 - iv. The front end of the soapbox must be 7 inches or higher from the ground. (to avoid bottoming out)
 - v. All cars must weigh no more than 176 lbs. (not including the driver).
 - 1. There will be point deductions for overweight crafts. Please plan accordingly.
- d. Seat Belts Driver's <u>cannot</u> be strapped into the craft. This will create a hazard should we have the need to extract you from your craft.

2 Drivers

- a. Max of two Drivers per vehicle. (but you can have a total of 5 people on your team)
- b. Drivers must be at least 18 years old.

3 Costumes

- a. Closed-Toe Shoes All team members must wear closed-toe shoes during load in and event day. No exceptions!
- b. No bare bodies Costumes must fully cover your arms, legs, etc...we do not want your skin exposed in case you crash, or fall out of your soapbox.
- c. Helmets Are mandatory! We will provide. (we have sizes small to XL)
 - If you need a bigger helmet than this, you need to bring a motorcycle helmet to fit your head. It must be DOT
 approved for street use, not just a sexy helmet. We will make final determination on any non-Red Bull provided
 helmets.
 - ii. Eye Protection Sunglasses are allowed for your skit but not allowed for driving down the course. Glasses of any type are subject to creating eye damage. Contact lenses must be worn if pilot needs corrective lenses.
 - iii. Goggles are an acceptable option.

4 Props

- a. If you use any props during your skit, it must be cleaned up right after, by your team.
- b. All props must be approved by Red Bull. Please send your plan to your crew liaison by the deadline
- c. Items NOT permitted include:
 - i. Projecting items into crowd (i.e. swag, candy, t-shirts, food, etc...)
 - ii. Air horns over 200 psi Heat producing elements
 - iii. Flares
 - iv. Smoke bombs
 - v. Firecrackers
 - vi. High-pressure cylinders
 - vii. Chemicals
 - viii. Liquids
 - ix. Fire
 - x. Dry Ice
 - xi. Heavy duty battery operated machinery on craft

5 Alcohol

- a. No alcohol consumption until after the race! No drugs etc. or your whole team will be disqualified.
- b. Red Bull reserves the right to disqualify anyone who is caught or appears to be drinking, or intoxicated.

6 Sponsors

- a. Maximum of four sponsors.
- b. No alcohol beverages, no other beverage brands, no politically driven sponsors
- c. All sponsors must be approved by Red Bull prior to the event.
- d. All corporations (sponsors or team) must sign a release allowing Red Bull to use their logo.
- e. Sponsor area on the craft is LIMITED to 2 12"x12" spaces on your craft.
 - i. Anything larger will be removed or covered on site.
