THE WORKSHOP

The World Bank, Columbia University, MIT, the University of Nairobi and Groupshot, supported by the Rockefeller Foundation, will be hosting a consultative workshop on current efforts to collect key data for paratransit and flexible transit services.

The workshop aims to more systematically share and compare experiences of collecting paratransit data in different parts of the world and to solidify a growing network around non-scheduled and non-stop-based transportation data.

The workshop also aims to discuss whether, based on experiences so far, there exists a need to modify the GTFS or develop a new data format and if so, what such a standard might look like.
