Cellphone companies 'lying' about radiation

There is proof that exposure to microwave radiation from cellphone and Wi-Fi masts can cause cancer, suicidal tendencies, impaired judgment, fatigue, lowered immunity and neurological damage.

So said retired British military intelligence scientist Barrie Trower, who was in Fourways last week warning the community on the lurking danger behind microwave radiation.

"If cellphone or Wi-Fi companies tell you there is no proof masts are harmful, they are lying. Just point them back to their own research," said Trower.

He said one of the biggest studies into the effects of microwave exposure, known as the Ecolog Study, was conducted by the mobile industry itself.

It proved that cellphone radiation can initiate and promote cancer, damage DNA and alter sleep patterns, among

many other ailments.

"Three studies have shown that mitochondrial DNA, passed from mother to daughter down the female line, is being permanently damaged by radiation.

"This leads to genetic diseases like Down's syndrome and cystic fibrosis. This genetic damage can never be repaired."

After succumbing to a number of

ailments linked to radiation, former Craigavon resident and founder of the Electromagnetic Radiation Research Foundation of SA Tracey-Lee Dorney said her family was forced to move out of their home after the I-burst tower was erected in the area.

She and other foundation members are conducting research projects into radiation, one at a local school which recently put Wi-Fi technology into the classrooms. "We are already picking up several cases of skin rashes and general ill-health among pupils and staff," said Dorney.

The *Review* asked spokesman for the Gauteng Department of Health Mandla Sidu whether the department was aware of the effects of cellphone tower radiation, and if any restrictions were in place.

"Not that I know of," he said. "This sounds like an expert's field at a higher level of government."

Trower calls for the rejection of radiation

By 1971, the Naval Medical Institute of the US had compiled a list of 2 300 research papers into the effects of microwave radiation.

According to Trower, the World Health Organisation only started looking into the effects of cellphone radiation on children in 2009, and would only start reporting on general issues in 2015. "This means the entire world is now being used in an experimental trial," he explained. "After World War II, a document called the Nuremberg Treaty was signed by allied countries which forbade experimentation on

the population without their informed knowledge and consent (also enshrined in the Bill of Rights in the South African Constitution).

"This binding agreement can be used as a golden bullet for people seeking legal redress from exposure to cellphone masts. You have the right to say no to being used in this experiment."

Further, for those residents living in the vicinity of a mast, Trower suggested they put up a screen shield near their beds using thick aluminum foil or thin tin attached to railing. "There are ways in which this technology can be safely

deployed by companies in the industry.

"A group of scientists studied over 2000 research papers and issued a document called the Bioinitiative Report, which established a level which they considered safe for general exposure." In his days as a military scientist during the Cold War, Trower was tasked with the responsibility of interviewing captured Russian spies. He learnt that they were infiltrating the West, and, using pulsed microwaves, targeted politicians and other influential people in order to affect their health and mental state.
