Summary and Highlights:

Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR) & National Election Watch (NEW) have analysed the selfsworn affidavits of current Chief Ministers in State Assemblies and Union Territories across the nation. These are the latest affidavits which were filed by them prior to contesting the elections to the State Assemblies/Union Territories.

Criminal Background

• <u>Chief Ministers with Criminal Cases:</u> Out of the all **31 Chief Ministers** analysed from State Assemblies and Union Territories **11 (35%) Chief Ministers** have declared criminal cases against themselves.




Figure 1: Chief Ministers with declared criminal cases vs clean background

Criteria for serious criminal cases

- 1. Offence for which maximum punishment is of 5 years or more.
- 2. If an offence is non-bailable
- 3. If it is an electoral offence (for eg. IPC 171E or bribery)
- 4. Offence related to loss to exchequer
- 5. Offences that are assault, murder, kidnap, rape related
- 6. Offences that are mentioned in Representation of the People Act (Section 8)
- 7. Offences under Prevention of Corruption Act
- 8. Crimes against women.





• <u>Chief Ministers with Serious Criminal Cases</u>: 8 (26%) Chief Ministers have declared serious criminal cases including cases related to murder, attempt to murder, cheating and dishonestly inducing delivery of property, criminal intimidation etc.




Figure 2: Chief Ministers with declared criminal cases – State wise




Figure 3: State wise assets detail of Chief Ministers








Figure 4: Share of Wealth among Chief Ministers

• Gender details of Chief Ministers: Out of 31 Chief Ministers, Only 3 (10%) Chief Ministers are women.




Figure 5: Overall Gender Report




Figure 6: Analysis of Chief Ministers on the basis of education




Figure 7: Analysis of Chief Ministers on the basis of age groups
