#### 1. MURRAY GEDDES AND BRIGHT STAR AWARDS NOMINATIONS -

The deadline for the Murray Geddes Memorial Prize and the Dark Sky Projects Bright Star Award is fast approaching. The deadline is Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2021. The Murray Geddes Memorial Prize is awarded by the Royal Astronomical Society of New Zealand to a person or persons for contributions to astronomy in New Zealand. This award is named after the prolific New Zealand observer of aurorae, variable stars, meteors, sunspots, comet discoverer, and inaugural director of Carter Observatory, Murray Geddes, who passed away during WW2 when on active service. The award is usually made annually. The recipient of the prize must be a New Zealand resident but need not be a member of the Royal Astronomical Society of New Zealand. Normally a person may only receive the award once.



The Dark Sky Project Bright Star award shall be awarded to a person or persons at intervals of not more than five years nor less than one year, for contributions in New Zealand in promoting astronomy to the public, or in astronomical education, or in promoting dark skies so as to allow astro-tourism to flourish.

#### 2. THE 2021 RASNZ CONFERENCE IS IN WELLINGTON -

The 2021 RASNZ conference is planned to be held in Wellington from Friday 9<sup>th</sup> until Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021. Come along for this special 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary conference! #### 3. A CALL FOR NOTICES OF MOTION -

### 4. THE KINGDON-TOMLINSON GRANT APPLICATION DEADLINE IS 1 MAY 2021 –

By-law J2 states, 'Applications may be made by any person or persons, or organisations, requiring funding for any projects or ventures which promote the progress of astronomy in New Zealand.'
