The plan, outlined by Superintendent Mary Ronan and members of her administrative team at the February 8, 2016, Cincinnati Board of Education meeting, builds upon CPS' groundbreaking My Tomorrow

Proposed elementary neighborhood school program focuses include: arts and culture, environmental science, student enterprise, **high-technology**, gifted, gender-based, dual language and Montessori.

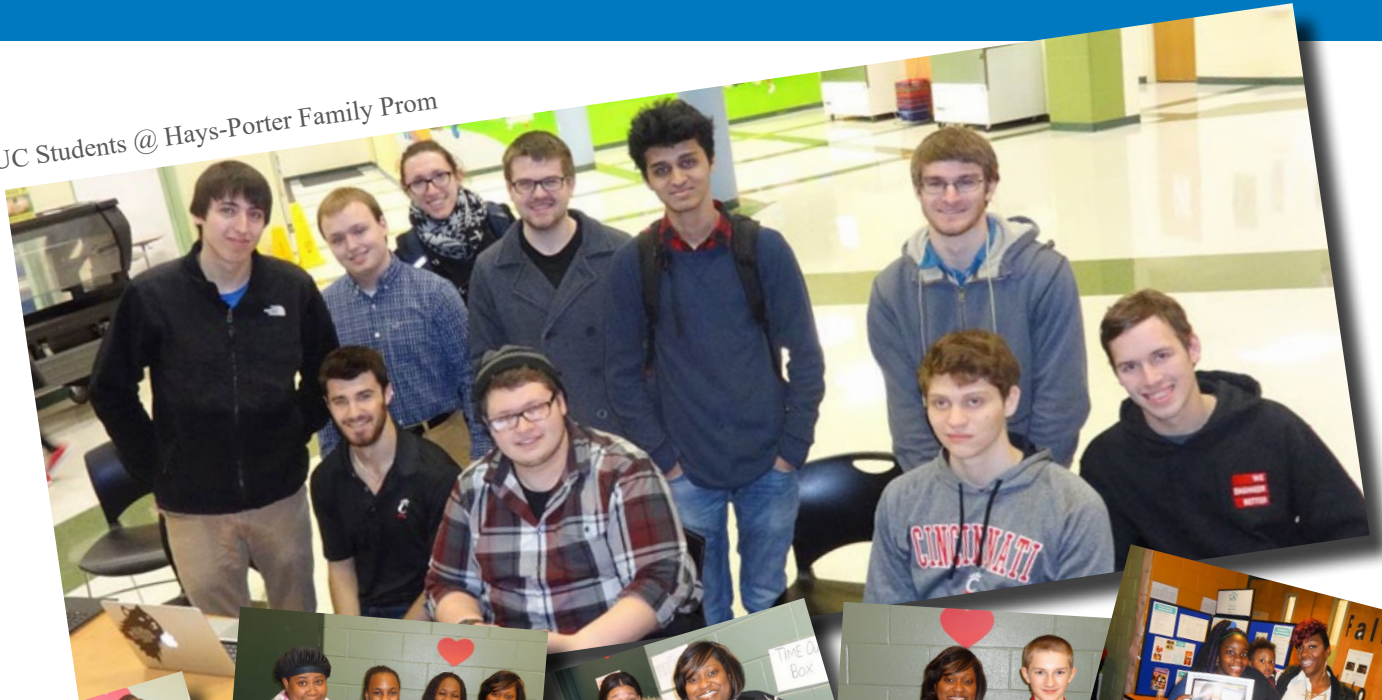
UC Students Helping Hays-Porter students
