We demand that the Moral Agenda and Moral Budget of the Poor People's Campaign: A National Call for Moral Revival be enacted. After seeing trillions of dollars transferred to corporations and the wealthy, we will not tolerate the lies of scarcity and the refusal to fully address systemic poverty and its interlocking injustices.

It's Time to RISE UP and DO *MORE* **M**obilize, **O**rganize, **R**egister, **E**ducate people for the movement who will use their VOICE and VOTE!
