

Map Rack Attack - SE Foster!

Because open data is awesome and bike rack locations matter, we are adding bike racks (and maybe other data?) to OpenStreetMap along SE Foster. Thank you for being here!

Time and Place

Date: Saturday 8/26/17

2pm: Meet at Creston City Park, near the pool, at 2pm ~4pm: Mappy Hour at Bar Maven, 6219 SE Foster Rd

Steps for success:

- 1. If needed, set up an OSM account: https://www.openstreetmap.org/user/new
- 2. If you have a smartphone, install an OSM editing app, or Mapillary:
 - a. I recommend "Go Map!!" for iPhone
 - i. Tutorial: http://learnosm.org/en/mobile-mapping/gomap/
 - b. For android, try Vespucci (but note it's not as user friendly as "Go Map!!"
 - Mapillary is an easy, fun option that lets you add street view pictures these help OSM contributors improve the map remotely! (it's on both iPhones and androids)
- 3. Enter your OSM account credentials in the app, and enable location.
- 4. We'll practice adding bike racks to OSM as a group!
 - a. Tags to add:
 - i. amenity=bicycle_parking (always include this)
 - ii. capacity=[some integer] (number of bikes that can fit can be an estimate)
 - b. more details:

- 5. If you want to branch out, try adding bus stop attributes (e.g. shelter=yes), business information, or benches!
- 6. Please tag changesets with "OSM PDX Mapathon"
- 7. Remember the golden rule of OSM: "Don't copy from other maps"
- 8. Please stay safe while mapping! Situational awareness is key!
