

# ENCOSH Platform Partnership Agreement

Both are collectively referred to as “Parties”.

## **Article 1. Purpose of the partnership**

The purpose of this agreement is to specify and formalize this partnership between the two Parties. In recognition of the challenges arising from the coexistence between humans and wildlife locally and globally, the association HISA (<http://hisaproject.org/>) has set up the ENCOSH project (ENhancing COexistence by SHaring).

As an international collaborative online platform, ENCOSH aims to foster the sharing of knowledge, skills, experiences, and the creation of collaborative networks of diverse stakeholders worldwide about local and global initiatives that contribute toward fostering Human-Wildlife coexistence. With this agreement, both Parties are committing to working together in an open-ended, constructive, and mutually respectful way.

## **Article 2. Areas of collaboration**

Areas of collaboration between the Parties are:

1. Sharing of information and activities relevant for the purpose of the Agreement.
2. Supporting each other in reaching synergies to achieve the purpose of the Agreement.
3. Any future opportunities or mutual needs that may arise.

## **Article 3. Responsibilities of the Partners**

### **Article 3.1. Engagement of the Partner**

By signing this agreement, the Partner commits to the following:

1. Submitting the main initiatives being developed by the Partner, contributing to Human-Wildlife coexistence to the ENCOSH platform, namely:

2. Submitting all the initiatives within two (2) months after the start of the Agreement and submit any new initiatives to be developed, as soon as possible, the latest every six (6) months;
3. Complying with the established guidelines regarding submission and review of the initiatives, as defined in the following link, through the online form available at: <https://encosh.org/en/publish/>;
4. Replying as soon as possible to the comments and questions made by members of the platform about your initiative (e.g, section comments);
5. Making regular updates on the initiatives, namely in what concern relevant data and new results, may they be positive or negative, the latest every six (6) months;
6. Disseminating the platform to the Partner’s network working on Human-Wildlife interactions, and inviting them to contribute to the ENCOSH Platform, namely by submitting initiatives, making comments or using platform tools.

**Article 3.2. Engagement of ENCOSH**

By signing this agreement, ENCOSH commits to the following:

1. Reviewing each initiative submitted by the Partner on the platform by adding comments and suggestions to make the technical sheet the most complete and understandable possible;
2. Creating a technical sheet for each reviewed initiative that will support the Partner to better highlight and communicate about its work to its network and on the field;
3. Translating each initiative in several languages (currently available in French, English and Spanish) in such a way that the Partner’s initiatives could have a wider reach and feedback worldwide;
4. Displaying on the platform a short text introducing the organization Partner and its logo, under the tab “Partners”, and have their initiatives featured on the slide-show of ENCOSH’s homepage;
5. Connecting the Partner with a wider audience of specialists and public interested in the topic of Human-Wildlife interactions;
6. Enhancing promotion of the Partner and its initiatives in ENCOSH's social media and dissemination actions whenever appropriate, and disseminate Partners' initiatives and activities to ENCOSH members.

**Article 4. Date and duration of the agreement**

This Agreement shall take effect upon signing by both Parties and has no end-date, unless either Party gives the other written notice of termination at least thirty (30) days before the intended end-date.
