- Thank you to Susan Riddles and Dave Hofflinger for working on the 2023 Budget.

Financial Secretary – Susan Riddles – written report submitted

- Total Offerings End of Oct. \$127,768.10 less \$3,829.15 Property Maintenance equals \$123,938.95 which is \$51,820.63 less than the amount needed to meet budget.
- Average weekly offering: \$2,018.17 which is up from last month and last year.
- Offering amount needed to meet budget: \$3,661.66, YTD weekly average is \$2,661.84 or an average of \$999.82 less than needed weekly.
- Missions Giving through November equals \$25,205.53 or 15.47% of total which include special designations and budgeted gifts to include the SE Districts and the amount for Kenyan mission.
- 2022: 18% Pledging: 31 of 41 units giving and eight nonmembers through November.

- See attached report with the following additional information:
 - LED light location replacement: some classrooms, two in trailer, four spotlights on the steeple (only two were functioning) and a security light facing the trailer.
 - Front Door Replacement Quote Note: only issue is the integration solenoid and keypad will not work. A spectacular door was viewed at a cost of \$30,000.
 - IPV Lease Trustees have not met yet. A suggestion is to again do a threeyear renewal with a 10 percent a year escalation clause. I'm meeting with Pastor Garay this week.

Old Business

 Recommended changes to the Constitution and Bylaws were mailed to Voting members.

New Business -

Budget – Amounts are very similar to last year:

- New Item: Issues, Etc., a Lutheran Public Radio podcast and radio program, is included in handouts. The Budget Committee is proposing we support Issues, Etc. as an outreach and publicity expense in the amount of \$1,000. For this amount, PIC will be advertised on the radio, in their newsletter, on Facebook and the Issues, Etc. Congregational Registry. They offer a wealth of information that includes: bible studies, preparation for Sunday's worship (when using the LCMS Lectionary), and theological insight on current religious and doctrinal topics. Pastor Singer concurred that they offer a wealth of teaching and knowledge. It is a Registered Service Organization of Synod and has synodical funding and oversite which is primarily funded by congregations. Therefore, it has been included in the budget and is also open for discussion. Funds are identified within the Outreach and Publicity under Comments.
- Administration: Included is a three percent salary increase for our staff which includes Pastor, our Administrator and Director of Music. There is a National Conference coming up in 2023 so we anticipate costs associated with that. Copier Lease, Office Expense, Phone/Internet, and Postage all slightly increased.
- Christian Growth: Decreased as there are no children in Sunday School. If that changes, additional money is available in Dedicated Funds. VBS was also budgeted.
- Elders Expense: Unchanged
- Worship Expense: Unchanged
- **Music Ministry: Lower** Copyright Licenses it was discovered that we had several licenses that were no longer needed. Maintenance was increased significantly this past year as the bells needed polishing and refurbishing. It reverted back to the original amount to cover piano tuning and organ maintenance. Dedicated Funds are available also. No music purchase requested as Aaron left a wealth of choir music and Sharon also composes and rearranges existing music.
- Pastoral Support: Mileage has increased so shouldn't affect budget. Remaining items are calculated fields. Pastor needs to advise the Treasurer on the percentage he wants put towards his Housing Allowance and Salary. NOTE: A special congregational meeting to vote on this must be held before January 15. Pastor Conferences the All Pastors conference will be held in the Spring and, the Synodical conference is no longer on the agenda.
- Fellowship: Unchanged
- Outreach: Added \$200 for Youth Ministry.
- **Stewardship**: Main cost is for Giving Envelopes and was decreased due to the reduced needed quantity.

• **Missions**: Historical pattern for Southern District is to increase it each year with a goal of it being at least 10 percent of the total budget. This wasn't done because we included Issues, Etc. in the Budget. The amount for supporting Pastor Becker and Kenya remains the same and continues until 2024 (5 years).

Church Property:

- Utilities were increased significantly due to 2022's actual expense being much higher than Budget and due to increasing electric costs. It is hoped that with Dave Hofflinger's recent upgrades to lights, etc., these extra funds won't be needed.
- Janitorial PIC currently has Success student, so nothing has been budgeted.
- Lawn Care Increased to reflect actual costs.
- Maintenance Costs Increased to reflect actual costs.
- Property Insurance Increases every year.
- Snow Removal Remains the same.
- Supplies Increased slightly.
- **Payroll Expense** calculated fields based on salary encouraging Pastor to join 403b matching 50 percent on every dollar for the first two percent.
- **Total Projected Offerings** based on historical data and projections (conservative) and based on 12 pledges received through today. There were a total of 17 pledges last year.
- **Projected Total Income** IPV's rental increase has been included.
- Total Net Income \$168,841.00, our estimated Projected Income reflects a deficit.
 Please note that PIC has not met their budget in the past ten years but Actual Year
 End Expenses have been less than Actual Income. Budgeted Expense are always
 more than Projected Income since we use previous historical giving from members,
 plate and pledges. Note: Budgeted amount keeps PIC from having to vote again to
 add in anything.

MOTION: Budget Committee makes the Motion to accept 2023 Budget as written. (Susan Riddles first/Greg Oberhaus second). Discussion. All in Favor. **MOTION PASSED**

New Business

- Altar Guild looking for additional volunteers to help set up and cleanup since Kim Lewis will be moving. Please let Kim Lewis or Greg Oberhaus know if you would be willing to help.
- Constitution and Bylaws, Membership Guidelines and Term Limitations for elected offices – changes made in October and opportunity for input was given.

MOTION: Motion made to approve changes to The Constitution and Bylaws as written. (Gloria Johannessen first/Susan Bell second).

Discussion: Council Committee initiated these changes and which after congregational approval, it will go to the Synod District Office for review. They will either make additional changes or approve it. Either way, it will take quite some time since their reviews are completed through a volunteer position. The changes will go into effect January 1, 2023 and become law in Maryland since PIC is incorporated here. Even if the Synod & District requires us to change something, we can keep the changes and go forward as a congregation although this is not advisable. We do not need to notify Maryland of these changes.

MOTION: Motion made to accept and move forward with the changes. (Gloria Johannessen first/Susan Bell second). All in favor. **MOTION PASSED**

Financial Secretary Report PIC Voter's Meeting March 19, 2023

At the end of February, the total offering received was \$20,280.67 less \$607.29 for the Property Maintenance Fund (so, **\$19,673.38**), which is \$15,047.55 less than the amount needed to meet the budget.

Our average weekly offering income for the month of February is \$2,649.75 for four weeks, which is up from \$1,936.33 average weekly for last month and up from \$2,271.66 last year.

Offering amount needed weekly to meet budget is \$3,857.88. YTD weekly offering average is \$2,253.41 or an average of \$1,604.47 less than needed weekly.

Detailed instructions are being prepared to accomplish Financial Secretary duties.

The proposed budget for 2023 is \$231,809.79, which represents a 4.6% increase in budget over 2022 and .5% over 2021.

The approved budget for 2022 is \$221,606.21, which represents a 3.4% decrease in budget.

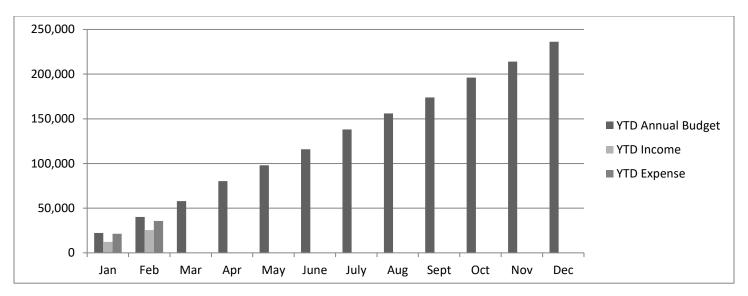

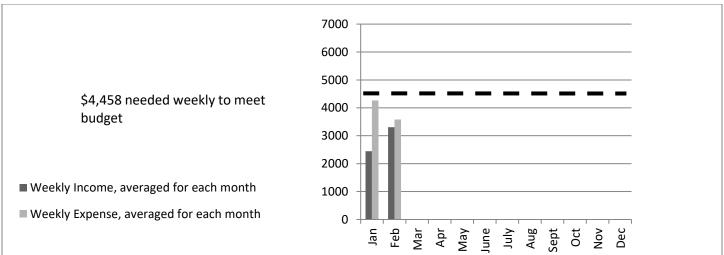

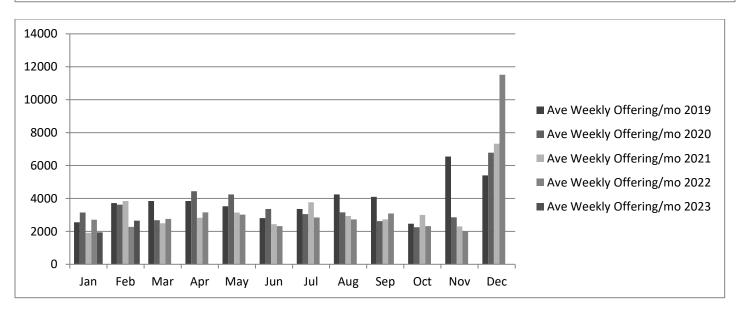

The following were accomplished since our last December Voter's Meeting:

- Have been replacing electrical outlets in the Sanctuary and Hallway. Also have been labeling
 outlets and switches to their respective electrical panel and circuit. This should make any future
 electrical maintenance much easier eliminating confusion about a circuit's electrical source.
- We have a new three-year Lease with IPV. The new Lease reflects a 10% increase in monthly rental with each new year.
- All Clean, Inc., whose owner is an IPV member, cleaned our carpet in the Sanctuary and Hallway and stripped and waxed the Fellowship Hall on Thursday, 26 January.
- Insulated the Men's Room Utility Closet where electrical conduit enters the building.
- Will seek pricing for a less expensive alternative Front Door replacement by using new door slabs, hinges, and exit crash/panic bars and locks with our existing door frames.
- Completed a rustproofing treatment to the inside of Front Door doorjamb with an auto/truck frame restoration material.
- No response has been received from several contractors for replacement of our Front Sign facing Route 194.
- Our FCPS Success Program student has been very successful in his janitorial duties he completes on Tuesday and Thursday for several hours.
- IPV provided another temporary repair to the damaged shed roof. The previous temporary repair failed due to high winds during several storms. Some wood areas of the roof have been damaged. IPV has offered to replace the roof shingles if we provide for the cost of the replacement plywood.
- With our warm weather and as Spring approaches began the weeding detail again starting along the flower beds bordering the Parking Lot.
- Continuous ongoing repair and/or updating of other minor facility items.

A DENTEN REMINDER.

"But the free gift is not like the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many. And the free gift is not like the result of that one man's sin. For the judgment following one trespass brought condemnation, but the free gift following many trespasses brought justification. Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men. Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."
