1. Type entry on ONE side only of 8 1/2 x 11 white paper.

- 3. DO NOT put your name, etc. ANYWHERE on any entered poem.
- 4. Send three (3) clear copies of EACH entry (with no illustrations).

5. AUTHOR MUST ATTEND TO CLAIM ANY AWARD.

6. BRING: a Chair, Lunch, Drinks (water, soft drinks [no alcohol]), Sun Hat, Title and First Line of Poems Submitted.
