Sri Krishna Stotras – Brahma Valvarta Puranam

The following is a collection of rare, short and sweet prayers on **Lord Krishna** by **Lord Shiva, Lord Brahma, Lord Dharma and Goddess Sarasvati** taken from **Brahma Vaivarta Puranam, Brahma Khandam**, and **Chapter 3**.

Phalashruti for Stotra By Lord Shiva - One who recites the hymn by **Lord Shambhu** attains **Siddhi** in all his deeds and victory in every step. He also begets the increase in wealth, friendship and decrease in enmity, sorrows and miseries.

Phalashruti for Stotra By Lord Brahma – One who recites the hymn by **Lord Brahma** with devotion in the morning will get all his sins and ill-fame destroyed and begets Bhakti on **Lord Govinda** and fame.

Phalashruti for Stotra by Lord Dharma – One who recites the sacred 24 names of **Lord Krishna** that came out from the face of **Lord Dharma** in the mornings will live in comfort and be victorious and he does not develop taste in doing unrighteous deeds. He is bestowed with the rare capacity to chant the name of **Lord Hari** at the time of his soul leaving the body and reach the abode of and perform devotional services to **Lord Hari**.

Phalashruti For Stotra By Goddess Sarasvati – One who chants the hymn by **Goddess Vani** attains erudition, intellect and wealth.
