As part of the LDP process, the City and County of Swansea has proposed TWO candidate sites in Clyne Valley Country Park for residential development. Both areas are currently designated as Green Wedge, and are next to other areas of Clyne Valley Country Park which are designated as Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
