The IPPC Logo: if you don't see it, don't use it! Even if a pallet may be perfectly safe without this logo, it could also mean that it was treated with chemicals!

SOME TREATMENT CODES ON PALLETS TO LOOK FOR:

[HT] = Heat treatment

[KD] = Kiln Dried.

[DB] = Debarked

How to Tell for Reuse?

If a Pallet Board Is Safe for



[MB] = Methyl bromide fumigation (Pesticide chemical) **Do not use it** for your craft projects or as firewood, find a waste-removal company who can dispose of it properly.


