AT THE APPROACH OF RAJAB & SHA'B

Adopt A Sunnah no.24

Rajab 1433 | May 2012

With the sighting of the crescent of Rajab, Rasulullah (sallallahu 'alaihi wa sallam) would anticipate and begin preparations for the month of Ramadhan. i.e, two months in advance. Sayyiduna Anas Ibn Maalik 🕸 reports that Rasulullah 🖔 would recite the following supplication when the Month of Rajab would commence:

Allahumma baarik lanaa fee Rajaba wa Sha'bana wa balligh-naa Ramadhan

Imaam 'Ataa Ibn Yasaar & - a distinguished Tabi'eesaid: "After Laylatul Qadr, there is no other night more virtuous than the middle (15th) night of Sha'ban ."

Imaam Shafi'e 🎄 has stated: "I have heard that du'as are accepted by Almighty Allah on five nights:

- 1) The night of Jumu'ah,
- 2; 3) The nights of the two 'Eids,

اَللَّهُمَّ بَارِكْ لَنا فِيْ رَجَبَ وَشَعْبانَ وَبَلَّغْنَا رَمَضَانْ

Translation: Oh Allah! Grant us Barakah (Blessing) during (the months of) Rajab and Sha'ban, and allow us to reach Ramadhan.

Rajab is the second of the four "Sacred months" in the Islamic Calendar which are referred to as: "Al-Ash-hurul hurum" (Surah

Tawbah, verse: 36)

The others are: Zhul-Qa'dah, Zhul -Hijjah and Al-Muharram. Explaining their significance the

'Ulamaa mention that during these months, good deeds are more virtuous and evil deeds are more detestable to Almighty Allah.

As for Sha'ban, there are authentic Ahadith that describe special significance for the 15th night.

Rasulullah **s** is reported to have said: "Certainly Almighty Allah forgives everyone on this night besides those who ascribe partners to Him and those who harbor enmity for others".

Note: There are no specific types of Salaah etc. that are prescribed for the Month of Rajab or the 15th night of Sha'ban. One may engage in whatever form of 'ibadah one is comfortable with.
