The Active Transportation Infrastructure Stimulus Program involves the creation of 35 routes that range from multi-use pathways to bike boulevards. When they are completed by the end of this year, Winnipeggers will be able to access 375 km of active transportation routes. The \$20.4 million program is funded equally by the Federal, Provincial and City governments.
